



EPINEPHRINE AUTO-INJECTOR TRAINING

This training will allow the general public and “off duty” EMS Personnel to become certified to carry and administer Epinephrine to Individuals experiencing Life-Threatening Anaphylaxis.

This is an excellent addition to your CPR / First-Aid training.
Perfect for Hike-Leaders, Volunteers and Professionals
who take people into the outdoors.

Program Details:

- Program Length is approximately 90 minutes (program cost runs \$25* to \$45)
 - Students are required to pass a practical and written test (for which you will be well prepared)
 - Students will receive a course-completion certificate
 - *This program can be combined with the standard First Aid / CPR / AED program
- Per California Emergency Medical Services Authority: “it is recommended that all businesses have access to epinephrine auto-injectors.”*

(The Fine Print)

Once you receive your auto-injector training certificate you will need to do the following:

- Mail your auto-injector training certificate into the state (details will be given) along with your application, current CPR card, and appropriate government fees (currently \$15)
 - Wait patiently for your “Epinephrine Auto-Injector Certification Card” from the state
 - Take the card to your doctor to receive a prescription for an Epinephrine Auto-Injector
 - Take your prescription to your pharmacy to receive your Auto-Injector
 - You are now legally able to carry and administer Epinephrine to someone with life-threatening Anaphylaxis
