

CLASS INFORMATION:

The class will run from 9:00 to approximately 3:30 at the Tapia section of Malibu Creek State Park. (See Maps Below) Please try to arrive by 8:45 so we can start on time.

If for any reason you need to change your RSVP, please let us know as soon as possible, we normally have a waiting list for the class and if a slot opens up, we like to notify the wait list as soon as possible.

Bring your lunch – there is no place close by to get food and we only break for about 30 minutes for lunch.

Do not go into the main entrance of Malibu Creek State park which is just south of Mulholland. The Tapia entrance is approximately one mile south of the main park entrance on the same side of Las Virgenes Rd (west side). There will be a sign there that says Malibu Creek State Park. If you reach the traffic light at Piuma Rd you have gone slightly too far south.

From the 101fwy exit Las Virgenes Rd heading south, just past Mulholland you will see the main entrance to Malibu Creek State Park - **Go Past the main entrance..**Stay on Las Virgenes for approximately one more mile.

Just past the sign for Camp David Gonzales start looking for the sign that says Malibu Creek State Park. Make a right into the entrance and an immediate right to the pay kiosk. There will be an electronic pay station just before the kiosk to pay your \$13 parking fee (be sure to take your receipt for dashboard display).

Just past the kiosk you will go left following the signs to the Salvation Army camp. We will be at the last set of picnic tables on the right prior to reaching the Salvation Army gates. Parking is there on the right.

What to bring to class:

Appropriate clothing for the weather

Camp chair (the picnic tables will only accommodate about 10 people)

Water / Snacks / Lunch (there is no place close by for food or drinks).

Notepad and pen (if you care to take notes).

Sunscreen (although the Oaks we are under provide shade most of the day).

Insect repellent (not usually an issue).

Any Survival Kit items you would like to discuss.
