

Cyanotype Workshop with Laura Feeney

Join textile artist, Laura Feeney, at the Maddog Gallery in Challis, Idaho July 19 from 12 - 3 PM for a workshop exploring cyanotype and the everyday materials that surround us. Participants will go home with several paper prints of varying sizes and will have the option to print on fabric for an additional cost.

Cyanotype is a chemical process that creates blue, and white prints on paper, fabric, or other materials using the sun. In the 1800s, artist and scientist Anna Atkins used this process to create the world's first published book of photographs. On July 19, we'll use this process to create beautiful prints of our own.

What we'll learn:

- what is cyanotype and how to mix it
- how to apply the chemicals
- exposure and development
- substrate selection
- material selection

What to bring:

- materials to print, items that will leave an image...
 - pressed flowers or leaves, lace, jewelry, bones, rocks, toys, tools; anything with an interesting shape!
- older clothes
- an open mind
