# Reporting Unsportsmanlike, Technical, and Disqualifying Fouls

- Ensure scorekeepers record Personal Fouls with a P,
  Technicals with a T, Unsportsmanlike Fouls with a U,
  and Disqualifying Fouls with a D
- Brief the scorekeepers prior to tip-off
- During play, report all fouls properly and clearly:
  - "White 6 Unsportsmanlike Foul, C-2, excessive contact two free throws and possession for Black"

# Player Disqualifications (ejections)

- Players are disqualified (ejected) for:
  - Two Unsportsmanlike fouls (of any kind)
  - Two Technical fouls (of any kind)
  - A U-foul combined with a Technical
  - One Disqualifying foul
  - Five Fouls = "exclusion" (different than disqualification)

# Reporting U/T/D Fouls

- Use breaks or Time Outs to ensure scorekeepers have recorded U/T fouls correctly and that U-fouls are classified on the back of the sheet – <u>especially C-2's</u>
  - Rocky View is suspending players who accumulate three
    C2 U-fouls, even if there is no disqualification involved
  - If you call a C-2 in a Rocky View league game fill out an incident report ASAP after the game

# Disqualified Players Are Not Always Required To Leave The Gym

- Disqualified players can stay on the bench when:
  - Two U-fouls, a U-foul and a Technical, or regular five fouls
- Players must leave the gym if Disqualified for:
  - Two Technical Fouls (for unsportsmanlike conduct)
  - A Disqualifying Foul
  - You feel it is necessary for the player to leave the gym
- Players/coaches sent out of the gym will be suspended by their league

# **Coach Disqualifications (ejections)**

- Coaches are disqualified (ejected) for:
- A Disqualifying Foul
- Two "Coach" Technical Fouls
- One "Coach" Technical Foul combined with two "Bench" Technical Fouls
- Disqualified coaches must ALWAYS leave the gym

### **Dealing with Parents and Spectators**

- Meet the gym supervisor(s) before the game
  - Refresh/discuss protocols for policing the stands
- Professionalism at ALL TIMES before/during/afterward
- Avoid "rabbit ears" and allow spontaneous reactions
- If a spectator needs to be addressed locate the gym supervisor and direct them to the offending person
- Continue to reclaim the high ground

#### After the game – YOU MUST DO THE FOLLOWING

- Ensure U-fouls and Technicals are properly recorded on the scoresheet
- Ensure Technicals are explained on the back of the scoresheet – were they for unsportsmanlike conduct?
- Ensure <u>C-2</u> U-Fouls (excessive contact, rough play) on the back of the scoresheet
- Explain any <u>disqualifications</u> on back of the scoresheet

# When To Fill Out An Incident Report at <a href="https://www.cboa.ca">www.cboa.ca</a>

- When a player gets a <u>C-2 Unsportsmanlike Foul in a</u> <u>Rocky View League Game</u> (3 C-2's = suspension)
- When you eject a player or coach from the game
- When you have a spectator removed from the gym
- When you experience any actions that jeopardized the referees' safety before, during, or after the game



# **HS Tournament Games**

When you eject players/coaches/parents...

## **Ejections/DQ's during HS Tournaments**

- Players disqualified from a tournament game must sit out their team's next game IF the DQ is for:
  - A Disqualifying Foul
  - Two Technical Fouls for unsportsmanlike conduct
  - Two C-2 Unsportsmanlike Fouls
  - A combination of a C-2 U-foul and a Technical Foul for unsportsmanlike conduct

# **Ejections/DQ's during HS Tournaments**

- Players disqualified from a tournament game are NOT required to sit out the next game IF the DQ is for:
  - Five fouls (even if one is a U-foul or a T)
  - Two non-conduct T's (delay of game, etc.)
  - Two Unsportsmanlike Fouls that ARE NOT BOTH C-2
    - C-1/C-3/C-4/C-5 + C-2 = DQ but no suspension

#### When You Have a DQ in a Tournament Game:

- Ensure all U/T fouls are recorded properly AND specifics of ejection on the back of the scoresheet
- After your games <u>check the schedule</u> and note where/when the team's next game is
- ASAP <u>fill out an online incident report</u> remember to include the date/time of the offending team's next game in the written details space provided

# WHEN YOU DISQUALIFY A PLAYER, COACH, OR SPECTATOR FROM ANY GAME, ANYWHERE, AT ANY LEVEL... YOU MUST FILL OUT AN ONLINE INCIDENT REPORT AS SOON AS POSSIBLE
