

Shirley Osborne - short bio



Shirley Osborne is a keynote speaker and women's leadership strategist whose U.S. roots include 15 years of deep engagement in Phoenix, Arizona.

There, she developed and directed leadership and education programs for girls and young women. She founded the Girls Education Project to bring growth training to valley schools and Boys & Girls Clubs, and was co-founder of the Arizona Girls Roundtable at Florence Crittenton. She also co-authored and edited *The State of Arizona's Girls – Take Note, Make Change*, to bring attention to the lived experiences of young women in the state.

Today, drawing on her experience as Regional Representative for Commonwealth Women Parliamentarians for the Caribbean, Americas and Atlantic Region, and then Vice-chairperson of the Commonwealth Parliamentary Association, Shirley partners with organisations to advance women's leadership pipelines, with a focus on resilience, authenticity, and inclusion, and brings U.S. organisations fresh strategies on how women can transform leadership spaces with courage, vision, and impact.

She inspires American audiences and organizations to embrace courage and purpose in women's leadership, across cultures and generations.
