Meeting of the Board of Managers

A meeting of the Board of Managers of the Elisabeth Severance Prentiss Foundation was held at PNC's Cleveland corporate offices in the conference rooms of the 35th Floor.

The following members of the Board of Managers were present: Pamela A. Alexander, William R. Robertson, Richard W. Mack, Mary A. Smith and Dominic V. Perry.

Ms. Alexander presided.

The Board discussed PNC's request to act as a client reference. It was agreed that PNC could use Prentiss as a reference, and Ms. Alexander would be the contact person for that reference.

The Board of Managers was presented with the investment review of the Foundation's current holdings and the Trustee's report of funds available for discretionary granting by Mr. Danahey. The Board discussed targets for ideal grant spending in the upcoming months and years to minimize taxes and maximize giving. At the time of the meeting, the Board was given a spending benchmark of approximately \$4.5 million grants in 2019 to reach the 5% benchmark, with the caveat that there are still available carryovers if that figure is not met.

Having been previously given access to all current grant's progress reports and mailed the remaining payment schedule, The Board of Manager's were presented with all outstanding grant commitments and approved the continued payments of Previously Approved Grants (the full list of which below).

The Board of Manager's were then presented the new grant requests. To follow is a list of all approved, deferred and declined requests.
