Who is covered by this policy?

All Trustees of SPACE.

What is covered in this policy?

Trustees have a legal obligation to act in the best interests of SPACE and in accordance with SPACE's governing document, avoid situations where there may be a potential conflict of interest.

A conflict of interest is any situation in which a trustee's personal interests or loyalties could, or could be seen to, prevent the trustee from making a decision only in the best interests of the charity.

Key points about identifying conflicts of interest

A conflict of interest exists even where there is the possibility that a trustee's personal or wider interests could influence the trustee's decision making.

Conflicts of interests may arise where an individual's personal or family interests and/or loyalties conflict with those of SPACE.

Such conflicts could:

- · discourage free discussion;
- · result in decisions or actions that are not in the interests of SPACE
- · risk the impression that SPACE has acted improperly

Purpose

The purpose of this policy is to protect the integrity of SPACE's decision-making process, to enable our stakeholders to have confidence in our integrity and to protect the integrity and reputation of volunteers, staff and trustees.

This policy is meant to supplement good judgment and staff, volunteers and trustees should respect its spirit as well as its wording.

The Declaration of Interests

We ask trustees to declare their interests annually. A declaration of interest form is provided for this purpose.

The declaration of interests needs to be updated at least annually and also when any changes occur.

If you are not sure what to declare, or whether/when your declaration needs to be updated, please err on the side of caution. If you would like to discuss this issue, please contact the CEO & Founder for confidential guidance.

Data Protection

The information provided will be processed in accordance with data protection principles as set out in the Data Protection Act 2018. Data will be processed only to ensure that staff and trustees act in the best interests of SPACE. The information provided will not be used for any other purpose.

What to do if you face a Conflict of Interest

If there is a situation which will be a long term conflict this must be discussed with the board of trustees (in particular the chair) at the earliest convenience and a decision made on how to proceed.

At the beginning of all meetings you must declare immediately if there is an item on the agenda where they may be a conflict of interest. After disclosure, the individual may be asked to leave the room for the discussion and may not be able to take part in the decision depending on the judgement of the staff members, volunteers and trustees present at the time.

Any such disclosure and the subsequent actions taken will be noted in the minutes.

Decisions taken where a Trustee has an Interest

In the event of the board having to decide upon a question in which a trustee has an interest, all decisions will be made by vote, in line with the organisation's constitution.

Recording Disclosure of Interest

All decisions, including the declared conflict and the outcome must be reported in the minutes of the board.



SPACE Board of trustees - Declaration on interests

The Charity Commission recommends that all charities should hold a trustees' register of interests, indicating where there may be a potential conflict of interests with other charities, organisations, companies or individuals that influences or prevents a trustee from acting in the best interests of the charity.

Furthermore, trustees are required to declare all other charities of which they are also trustees; such information is made available publicly on the SPACE listing on the Charity Commission website.

Please complete and return the attached form, which will be retained at the charity's registered offices and should be updated annually or as circumstances changes.
