The essay should conform to the following:

- Applicant’s name, school, and essay topic should be typed at the top of each page.
- Essay should be no more than two doubled spaced pages(8 ½ x 11), using a 12 point font, with one-inch margins addressing the following topic:

“What are the three greatest challenges you think you may encounter during your freshman year of college?”

Once your scholarship application packet is received and reviewed, the scholarship chairman will contact you to schedule an interview. The interview date is listed below:
