## Essay

The essay should include the following:

- Applicant's name, school, and essay topic should be typed at the top of each page.
- Essay should be no more than two doubled spaced pages(8 ½ x 11), using a 12 point font, with one-inch margins addressing the following topic:

## "What are the three greatest challenges you think you may encounter during your freshman year of college?

Acceptable forms of income verification are limited to W-2(s) for 2021 or completed 2021 income tax return(s).
