Overall Performance

Motherwell continues to perform commendably, achieving an 88.22% pass rate—a slight improvement of 0.19% from the previous year.

Highlights:

- Vulumzi Secondary School showed a significant improvement of 12% compared to 2023.
- **Douglas Mbopa Secondary School** experienced a 7% decline.
- A steady increase in the number of learners writing matric was observed, totalling 1,707 in 2024.
- The number of progressed learners rose by 48% compared to last year, contributing to the minimal overall improvement.

Gateway Subjects Performance



Performance in key subjects declined compared to 2023:

- Accounting: Dropped by 3% to 85%
- **Physical Sciences:** Dropped by 4% to 77%
- Mathematics: Dropped by 2% to 83%

Despite these drops, Motherwell outperforms national, provincial, and district averages in Mathematics and Accounting. However, Physical Sciences performance trails the district by 1%.

Concerns:

The number of learners enrolling in Mathematics, Physical Sciences, and Accounting remains below 20% over the past five years. This is alarming as these subjects are crucial for entering higher education programs linked to the motor manufacturing industry and emerging ICT and Fourth Industrial Revolution (4IR) sectors in Gqeberha. Addressing this issue requires urgent attention from schools, civil organizations, businesses, government, and other stakeholders.





Furthermore, although English pass rates exceed 98%, educators highlight that poor English proficiency remains a barrier to success in gateway subjects. This contradiction reflects broader challenges faced by township and rural schools nationwide.
