

At Modern-Geo we value our community and we believe that we are only as strong as our youth. With this in mind we have established a scholarship program through which students can apply for our services at no cost for community and education based service projects. This program is a first-come-first-served basis and applications are evaluated based on the thoroughness of the proposal, value to the community, and need of the youth. Funds are allocated on January 1st each year and are available until they are gone. This

scholarship is open to any youth between the ages of 12 to 18 who are involved in a community service project that benefits the community through education, service, or research. (ex: An Eagle Scout Service Project or a Girl Scout Gold Award Service Project.)

To apply for this scholarship, a proposal must be submitted to Modern-Geo in writing at least 4 weeks prior to the start of the project. In the proposal, the project manager (youth applicant) must articulate the following in a professional manner.

The proposal must include the following topics;

- A title page with the name of the project and the name of the youth applicant, contact information, and associated organization (if any)
- An Executive Summary of the project with a table of contents to follow
- A stated mission of the project described in detail with anticipated outcomes, also to include the intended community benefit of the project
- Anticipated costs of the project (this includes time and expense as well as materials, permitting, etc.)
- How you would like to leverage Modern-Geo's resources
- A detailed conclusion with next steps for the project
- A list of applicable citations for sources used to draw your conclusions
- A list of three or more adults advisors or stakeholders that can vouch for your work in this project

To submit your application, please create a PDF of your proposal and attach it with a brief cover letter written as a the body of an email.
