

The Franklin Gothic typeface derives from earlier nineteenth century models when many of the twenty-three foundries consolidated into American Type Founders (ATF) in 1892. American Type Founders' head designer, Morris Fuller Benton is credited with designing the type in 1902. The Franklin Gothic typeset is said to be influenced by Bethold's Akzidenz-Grotesk types. It was given its name in honor of Benjamin Franklin who was also a fruitful printer. Today Franklin Gothic is being used in many advertisements and newspaper headlines. It's also highly used in a variety of media from billboards to books. Some of the more notable uses of it in design is Star Wars. The films used Franklin Gothic Condensed typeface for its subtitles although the "A long time ago in a galaxy far, far away..." title card is set in Franklin Gothic. Another notable use, Franklin Gothic Heavy was used for both Run-DMC and Ramones' band logo. The U.S. military even uses Franklin Gothic Extra on their uniforms.
