**Thursday, September 19, 2019:** Intake and set up of artwork 1:00pm to 3:00pm

**Friday, September 20, 2019:** Judging of Show by **Jan Wilken, LWS.**

After judging, ribbons will be displayed.

Exhibit viewing hours: Monday – Friday 9am-4pm.

**Saturday September 21, 2019:** Reception, Awards and Parade of Prizes 5pm to 8pm.

**Thursday, October 3, 2019:** Take down of Exhibit and Pick up art work 9:00am – 10:00am.

**ALL ARTWORK MUST BE PICKED UP PROMPTLY in this hour.**

#### Eligibility:

Open Call to all Artists, 18 years and older.

#### Four Categories:

**Art under Glass**

**Art Not Under Glass**

**Photography**

**3- D \*\* Artist must supply their own pedestal\*\***

**Awards:** **Best in Show:** Ribbon + \$200.00

In each of the four qualifying categories:

**First Place:** Ribbon + \$100.00

**Second Place:** Ribbon + \$50.00

**Third Place:** Ribbon + \$25.00

**Honorable Mention:** Ribbon only

**All prizes are not automatically awarded in each category. Prizes are awarded based on number of entries in the category and at the discretion of the Judge.**

The Show Committee will apply the following formula to decide the maximum number of awards to be given in a category:

1-5 entries in category—1<sup>st</sup> & 1 honorable mention.

5-10 entries in category-- 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> & 1 honorable mention.

11-15 entries in category—1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup> & 1 honorable mention.

16 entries and above—1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup> & 2 honorable mentions.

**Our Juror:** *Jan Wilken, LWS is a professional artist and teacher. She has had the privilege of judging numerous art exhibits in Louisiana and Mississippi. She is a Lifetime Signature Member of the Louisiana Watercolor Society. Three of her paintings were included in the Hilliard Museum Exhibition: "Aquarellists: Louisiana Watercolorists" in Lafayette, Louisiana. Nine mannequin paintings were*

*included in the Four Seasons Exhibit at the West Baton Rouge Museum of Art. In 2016 she published "Common Sense Composition for Artists, Photographers and Wannabes," an easy to read composition handbook. Her artwork is also included in numerous private and corporate collections in this country and abroad. **Entry:** Entrants must be 18 years or older.

A non-refundable entry fee is **\$10.00 per piece** for Lacombe Art Guild **members**. A non-refundable entry fee for **\$15.00 per piece** for **non-members**. There is **no limit on number of pieces entered** per artist.

All entries:

- must be "For Sale",
- must have been completed within the last two years and not previously shown in any Spring or Fall Lacombe Art Guild Show,
- must be original and created without supervision, not copies, derivatives or based in any way on either copyrighted or published paintings or photographs.
- reproductions or art made from molds, patterns or kits or done in a workshop are not allowed,
- if two dimensional, is limited to a minimum image size of 8" X 10" and maximum framed size 36" X 72".
- must be dry, framed and **ready to be hung with screw eye or D rings and wire only. No saw tooth hangers are allowed,**
- must not show any depiction of nudity, violence, political or spiritual views.
- Unframed, Gallery wrapped canvases with sides 1.5 inch or greater are acceptable, **provided the art is suitably finished on all sides and with no exposed staples.** Any canvas under 1.5 inches must be framed.
- Three-D work is limited to size of 50 pounds and artist must provide pedestal. **NO EXCEPTIONS!**

Participants are asked to provide complete entry form and title card(s) with their artwork\* and entry fee (**Cash or checks made out to LAG--no credit cards accepted**) to the Pelican Room, Lakeview Regional Medical Center, 95 Judge Tanner Blvd, Covington, on Thursday, September 19, between the hours of 1:00pm and 3:00pm. \* **ALSO, Please affix a second card on the back of your painting with the title, your name, size, medium and the price.**

**Sales:** Lacombe Art Guild retains a **20% commission on all sales** of entries. Please price your work accordingly. All sold artwork must remain on exhibition until the conclusion of the show, Thursday, October 3<sup>rd</sup> at 9am.

**No Early Pick Up!** If you cannot meet this deadline, please make arrangements for someone to pick up your artwork. **Artwork not picked up will become the property of Lacombe Art Guild.**

**Liability:** Although the utmost care will be taken in handling the artist's work, the Lacombe Art Guild nor the Lakeview Regional Medical Center can be held liable for damage, loss or theft, whatsoever the cause. Sending a work of art to the show shall imply agreement on the part of the artist to all conditions set forth in this prospectus.
