Open Call to all Artists, 18 years and older.

First Place: Ribbon + \$100.00

Two Honorable Mention: Ribbon only

**All prizes are not automatically awarded in each category. Prizes are awarded at the sole discretion of the Judge.**

#### **Juror Mary Monk**

Mary Monk has been an award winning professional artist for over twenty years. Her work can be found in a myriad of public and private art collections. She received the majority of her artistic training through classical drawing lessons but is a self-taught pastelist. She is an active member of the Degas Pastel and the Pastel Society of America. Mary's primary medium is pastel and she is mostly known for her country/urban landscapes. No matter the subject, mood and light are always the true focus of her paintings. **Entry:**

Entrants must be 18 years or older. **Non-refundable entry fee is \$10.00 per piece for Lacombe Art Guild members.** Non-refundable entry fee is \$15.00 per piece for non-members. There is a four (4) piece limit per artist. All entries must be "For Sale". Artwork must have **been completed within the last two years and not previously shown in any Spring or Fall Lacombe Art Guild Show.** All artwork must be original and created without supervision.

Art must not be copies, derivatives or based in any way on either copyrighted or published paintings or photographs. Reproductions or art made from molds, patterns or kits are not acceptable. Artwork done in workshops are not allowed. All art work must be dry, framed and ready to be hung with screw eye or D rings and wire only. **No saw tooth hangers are allowed.**

**Submissions of artwork must not show any depiction of nudity, violence, political or spiritual views.**

Gallery wrapped canvases are acceptable, provided the art is suitably finished on all sides and with no exposed staples. Three D work is limited to size of 50 pounds. **Artist must provide pedestal.** Two dimensional artwork is limited to a minimum image size of 8" X 10" and maximum framed size 36" X 72" due to limited space.

Participants are to bring completed entry form, entry fee (Cash or checks made out to: LAG) **no credit cards**, and their artwork to the Pelican Room, Lakeview Regional Medical Center, 95 Judge Tanner Blvd, Covington, Thursday, March 21, between the hours of 1:00pm and 2:00pm.

**\*Please also affix a card on the back of your painting with the title, your name, and the price.**

**Sales:**

Lacombe Art Guild retains a **20% commission on all sales** of art. Please price your work accordingly. All sold artwork must remain on exhibition until the conclusion of the show, Thursday, April 4 at 9am.

**No Early Pick Up!** If you cannot meet this deadline, please make arrangements for someone to pick up your artwork. Artwork not picked up is subject to a \$25.00 fee and will be enforced. After Thursday, April 11 any unclaimed art becomes the property of Lacombe Art Guild.

**Liability:** Although the utmost care will be taken in handling the artist's work, the Lacombe Art Guild nor the Lakeview Regional Medical Center can be held liable for damage, loss or theft, whatsoever the cause. Sending a work of art to the show shall imply agreement on the part of the artist to all conditions set forth in this prospectus.
