- Feb. 24<sup>th</sup>/ March 2<sup>nd</sup>, 9am-12pm, to be confirmed. **Plates, Joists, Posts, Rafters Erection** (Cheese Room). Tutelage with master carpenter Gil Bliss. Must have basic skill with hand and power tools, may involve lifting and ladder work. Wear warm clothes, sturdy work gloves. Tentatively scheduled for Feb 24<sup>th</sup>, /March 2<sup>nd</sup> 9am-12pm. Dates are weather dependent. Beverages/ sandwiches provided.

- March 22, 9am-12pm. Yard Cleanup. We'll be clipping back vines, removing garden debris, and
  organizing and raking, to get ready for the growing season. Wear warm clothing and work
