James O'Donnell, BSc, M.S, Ph.D and former Professor of Marine Sciences at UConn's Avery Point, and currently the Executive Director of the Connecticut Institute for Resilience and Climate Adaptation (CIRCA).

His last ten years of study of the Long Island Sound and the adjacent Atlantic shelf is providing the public, Coast Guard, and environmental managers, with statistical, and scientific data in real time, of the events happening with global warming, in our area.
