TWO COMMON QUESTIONS I'VE GOTTEN....

"What makes you different from every other person with a drone? Can't I just pay someone to take pictures for me?"

- Yes, you can, but you will be on the wrong side of the law. A non certified pilot
 (without a Part 107 certificate) can be fined over \$1000 (per flight) AND THEIR
 CLIENT fined over \$10,000 (per flight) from the FAA if compensation is made. Even a
 realtor that has their own drone can face BOTH fines if they are not certified.
- 2. Quality flying—One thing I hate is rough aerial footage, but it seems like it's the norm out there. A jerky video is not a quality video. Don't settle for less!
- 3. Image quality—I have several drones that have cameras that range from 12 megapixel to 24 megapixel. CMOS sensor size, frames per second, 4K, 6K, HDR quality video? Quality should matter greatly to your project. Most amateur drone owners will have the lowest quality available and you get what you pay for. I want quality for my customers, so I invest in it!
- 4. Video and imagery editing—I admit, I'm no Hollywood cinematographer, but I like classy videos and pictures, so I touch them up and edit them to give you the presentation you're looking for. I also provide you with many final options so you can choose the one that you like best!
- 5. General liability– Insurance that can cover you as an additional insured.
- 6. Drone insurance– Because not all GLs cover every accident.
