SO FAR IN 2019...

The Trust has helped pilgrims visit various shrines and holy places. We have made more grants pilgrims travelling to Lourdes than to any other place, and this newsletter focuses of on some 2019's Lourdes pilgrims.

All the pilgrims travelled in groups, some organised by dioceses or schools. About half travelled on pilgrimages for people with special care needs, some as pilgrims and some to help care for pilgrims.

Lourdes is a small town (population 15,000) in South West France, set in the Pyrenees not far from the border with Spain. It is famous for the apparitions of the Virgin Mary to a young peasant girl, St Bernadette, in 1858. It is one of the most popular Marian shrines: millions of pilgrims from all over the world visit Lourdes each year

HELPING A SICK PERSON

A university student wrote:

'The pilgrimage helped to teach me how to care for someone else and was especially beautiful as I was helping her to make a pilgrimage of her own.

This added another dimension to my pilgrimage helping to make it a unique and special event which impacted my journey of faith with God.'

On the last day of the torch light procession, the young lad held the group candle on his medical transit bed and we all gathered around in the darkness, thanking God for His presence.'
