September tuition must be paid within thirty (30) days of registration. May tuition is due on the first day of school. Tuition for September and May is non-refundable. Last tuition payment for school year is April 1.

Lunch Bunch (pick up no later than 1:20PM or a late fee is assessed) is offered on specified days and is \$11.00 per day.

If payment for entire year is paid in full before January 1, of current school year, four (4) free vouchers for lunch bunch are earned and can be used for any regularly scheduled lunch bunch.
