

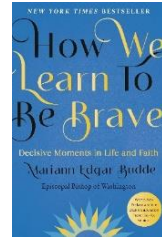
Westminster United - Announcements for February 22, 2026

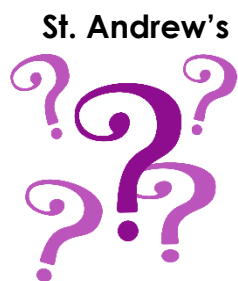
