

July 4th Rally in Thunder Bay: Stand with Grassy Narrows and Fort William First Nation Against Nuclear Waste Storage

Grassy Narrows First Nation, Fort William First Nation, and allies are calling on all supporters to gather in Thunder Bay on July 4th to oppose the proposed nuclear waste storage site near Ignace. The rally will amplify the voices of those who have long said "no" to nuclear waste in the Wabigoon River watershed.

Fort William stands strongly opposed to the transportation of nuclear waste through their territory while Grassy Narrows leaders have clearly stated that this project puts the people of Grassy Narrows in grave danger. The rally will take place in Thunder Bay on July 4th, 4pm at Waverly Park.
