Weekly Lessons

Each month the student will receive 4 or 5 lessons per month, one (1) lesson each week.* A lesson will be rescheduled if the student is sick, or if specific arrangements are made at least 48 hours in advance. If a call is not made 48 hours in advance (for a reason other than sickness), the lesson will not be rescheduled. I always do my best to accommodate each student's schedule, but I do ask that the student will make his or her lesson time a priority and not schedule other activities or appointments during the lesson time.

The student should bring the current sheet music to **every** lesson. Two (2) copies are helpful so that both the student and the instructor can read the music easily.

*For students that meet me at schools, there may be certain circumstances in which 4 lessons a month is not possible due to non-school days. Tuition will remain the same. See the Tuition Schedule for more details. Our regular travel fee is waived due to this circumstance.

Recitals

There are currently two (2) recitals each year. The Winter recital is held at a care facility in the afternoon and the Spring recital is held in the evening at a concert venue. I believe that music is meant to be shared with parents and the community. It is important that students prepare well in advance for the recital and not wait until the last week to do a majority of the practice. In the months of a recital (December & June, normally), students will receive three (3) lessons and will participate in the recital—which will count as a lesson. If a student chooses not to perform in the recital (not recommended) he or she will still be expected to attend, and the recital will still be counted as a lesson.
