Achillea millefolium (Yarrow) 'Cerise Queen'

Height: 18-30"

Spread: 24-30"

Full Sun

Zones 2-9

A native plant, yarrow is one of the easiest perennials to grow, as it will grow in nearly any sunny place, even if soil is poor or dry. 'Cerise Queen' forms low mounds of fragrant, ferny foliage with clusters of cherry-pink flowers on upright stems. Yarrow is good for cutting, fresh or dried. It's the perfect plant for a summer cottage garden.



Achillea millefolium (Yarrow)

Height 1-3' **Zone** 3-9
Spread 1-2'
Full Sun

Yarrow is a native North American plant that is very popular with pollinators. It is a hardy, versatile perennial with showy flower heads composed of many tiny, tightly-packed flowers above delicate, fern-like foliage. The flowers come in a variety of colors.



Achillea ‘The Pearl’ Superior

Height: 18-30”

Spread: 18-24”

Full Sun to Part Shade

Zones 3-9

Commonly called “Sneezeweed” or “Sneezewort”, this pretty little plant is not particularly allergenic, despite its name. ‘The Pearl’ bears clusters of fully double, small, white, pompom blooms with tiny yellow centers, suggestive of a large, double Baby’s Breath. This easily cultivated plant spreads readily to make an effective “wild” border and supplies copious cut flowers from spring until frost, enjoyed either fresh or dried.



Anise Hyssop

Height 3'

Spread 2-3'

Full Sun

Zone 4-9

This gorgeous late summer bloomer is loaded with blue-violet flower spikes from late July through September. This pollinator favorite has a lovely anise (licorice) fragrance. It likes full sun and is tolerant of drought and heat stress. Anise Hyssop pairs beautifully with Black-eyed Susan for a classic blue and gold combination.



Silver Mound Artemisia*

Height 12”

Spread 15-24”

Full Sun

Zone 3-9

This low-growing, mounding plant bears soft, silvery grey foliage and is perfect for rock gardens or edging. It does well in average to poor soil, as long as it is well-drained. It is an excellent plant to use in order to cut down on watering.



Alpine Aster Beauty Series - Dark Blue

Height: 12”

Spread: 18”

Full Sun to Part Shade

Zones 3-9

This deep purple alpine aster is an early summer bloomer, with many single-flowered stems rising from a compact basal rosette of grey-green leaves. Long-lasting flowers have showy yellow eyes. Perfect for the front of the border or rock garden in average soil and full sun, this alpine aster is attractive to butterflies but not to deer and dislikes excessive moisture.



Purple Dome Aster

Height: 18 in.

Zones 3-8

Full Sun to Mostly Sunny

This dwarf variety of New England Aster forms rich mounds of striking dark green foliage supporting purple, daisy-like blossoms with sunny yellow centers which remain in bloom from late summer to late fall. This durable and long-lasting bloomer supports bees, butterflies and other pollinators right up until season's end.



Bridal Veil Astilbe (Plume Flower)

Height: 18 in.

Part Shade

Zone 3-8

Brilliant white florets rise on a loose, gracefully arching plume. New leaves emerge bronze and fade to green. ‘Bridal Veil’ blooms early in the season. It is deer-resistant and prefers full to partial shade.



‘Maggie Daley’ Astilbe (Plume Flower)

Height: 24 in.

Part Shade

Zone 3-8

A mid-season bloomer, ‘Maggie Daley’ sports deep fuchsia flowers on rich, forest green foliage. Plumes form a very solid spate, which is excellent for drying.



‘Peach Blossom’ Astilbe (Plume Flower)

Height: 24 in.

Part Shade

Zone 3-8

A staple among Astilbes and very fragrant, ‘Peach Blossom’ is an early-season blooming and very floriferous plant with peach-pink, blocky plumes atop lush green and reddish-green foliage.



Balloon Flower Fuji Mix

Height 20”

Spread 12-18”

Full Sun to Part Shade

Zones 3-8

Adaptable and easy to care for, Fuji produces balloon-like buds that open into flaring star-shaped blossoms in blue, pink or white. Balloon flower does best in light, fertile, loamy, moist but well-drained soils (avoid damp sites and waterlogged soils) and is a perfect addition to beds and borders, cottage gardens or containers. Plant in groups for a more dramatic effect.



Balloon Flower 'Sentimental Blue'

Height 6-12"

Spread 10-12"

Full Sun to Part Shade

Zones 3-9

Forming a short but upright mound of green foliage, 'Sentimental Blue' produces puffy balloon buds that pop open into star-shaped violet-blue blossoms with deep indigo veins. Very attractive to butterflies, this balloon flower makes a lovely addition to the border, gravel and rock gardens, and cottage gardens. It tolerates a variety of soils, but prefers moist, well-drained locations.



‘American Goldfinch’ Baptisia

Height: 3 - 3.5 ft.

Spread: 4.5 - 5 ft.

Full Sun to Part Shade

Zone 4-9

This big, bold and beautiful native cultivar makes a dramatic statement in your garden come late spring. One of the most floriferous Baptisias, ‘American Goldfinch’ produces loads of bright yellow flower spikes for many weeks and attractive round seed pods in the fall. Easy to grow and thrives with little maintenance.



Baptisia australis (False Indigo)

Height 3-5' Zone 3-10

Spacing 2-3'

Full Sun to Part Shade

Baptisia forms a bush at maturity, with dense clusters of deep blue flowers on upright 4-16 inch long spikes. Baptisia lives a long time, but spends most of its energy underground when it is young and may not flower right away. But when it does, it is gorgeous! Over time, the blossoms get showier against blue-green foliage, and its seed pods are also attractive. Baptisia provides an excellent backdrop for other flowering plants later in summer.



Black-eyed Susan

Height: 24-30”

Spread: 24-30”

Full Sun

Zones 3-9

A classic favorite, Black-eyed Susan produces masses of showy, golden-yellow, daisy-like flowers from July to mid-October. Goldfinches love the seeds of this vigorous perennial that prefers fertile, loose soil.



Dicentra Spectabilis (Bleeding Heart)

Height: 27-35 in.

Part Sun to Part Shade

Zone 2-9

An old-fashioned favorite that bursts into rows of bright bleeding heart-shaped blooms on arching stems that rise above fern-like foliage in late spring. It forms a bushy upright mound of light green foliage with a somewhat ferny appearance. Dangling bright pink locket flowers on arching stems are excellent for cutting. Prefers rich, moist soil with partial shade, or at least protection from hot afternoon sun.



Dicentra Spectabilis Alba (White Bleeding Heart)

Height: 27-35 in.
Part Sun to Part Shade
Zone 2-9

An old-fashioned favorite that bursts into puffy, heart-shaped white flowers on deeply cut green foliage in late spring. It forms a bushy upright mound of light green foliage with a somewhat ferny appearance. Dangling white locket flowers on arching stems are excellent for cutting. Prefers rich, moist soil with partial shade, or at least protection from hot afternoon sun.



Bleeding Hearts are a long-time favorite. They like morning sunshine and afternoon shade and prefer moist, fertile, alkaline soil. They do well when planted among hostas. This Zone 3 perennial should be planted at the same depth as it is in the pot.



Butterfly Bush

Height: 3-5'

Spread: 3-5'

Full Sun

Zones 4-9

This favorite of butterflies and other pollinators is easily grown in average, medium moisture, well-drained soils in full sun. Showy spikes of fragrant lavender-purple flowers delight the eye of both humans and friendly insects. This plant provides beautiful summer to fall flowers when few shrubs are in bloom. Works best in borders, cottage gardens, rose gardens or butterfly gardens, particularly as a foundation plant.



Butterfly Weed (*Asclepias tuberosa*)

Height: 1-3 ft.

Spread: 1-2 ft.

Full Sun to Partial Shade

Zones 3-9

This deer-resistant member of the milkweed family is native to eastern North America and earns its name by attracting butterflies (particular queens and monarchs, whose larvae feed on its foliage) and other pollinators with its June- and July-blooming bright orange flowers and copious amounts of nectar. This upright perennial with oblong leaves is best adapted to sunny sites with well-drained or dry soil.



Campanula

‘Bellefleur Blue’

Height: 6-9”

Spread: 12-24”

Full Sun to Part Shade

Zone 2-9

Commonly known as “clustered bellflower”, this upright perennial forms a dense clump of ovate to lance-shaped leaves that support upward-facing, bell-shaped violets flowers that bloom in clusters in late spring to early summer. The flowers are attractive to hummingbirds, butterflies and other pollinators. ‘Bellefleur Blue’ is easy to grow in average, moist, well-drained soil.



Campanula 'Blue Clips'

Height: 6-12"

Spread: 8-12"

Partial to Full Sun

Zone 2-9

One of the most popular bellflowers, this plant forms a low, cushion-shaped mound of small green leaves with lots of upward-facing, bell-shaped, lavender-blue flowers. It will bloom for weeks if spent blossoms are removed regularly. 'Blue Clips' prefers well-drained soil and works well in rock gardens, edging and containers.



Centaurea montana

Height **12-24”**

Spread **12-18”**

Full Sun

Zone 3-8

Also known as perennial bachelor’s button, mountain cornflower or mountain bluet, Centaurea montana is an erect, clumping perennial featuring single, fringed, rich blue flowers, which appear in late spring atop grey-green, lance-shaped leaves. It is very easy to grow and tolerates both poor soil and drought.



Chelone obliqua 'Rosea'

Height 24-36"

Spread 16-24"

Part Shade

Zone 3-9

Commonly called "turtlehead", this native wildflower adapts beautifully to garden conditions. It is an excellent, sturdy, vertical perennial that forms a bushy mound of deep-green, deeply-veined foliage bearing upright stems of large, bright-pink hooded flowers beginning in late summer. Excellent for cutting, turtlehead thrives in moist or wet sites, especially at the waterside. Turtlehead attracts butterflies but resists deer.



Columbine (Aquilegia) - Kirigami Deep Blue & White

Height: 12-20”

Spread: 12-18”

**Part Sun or Light Shade, Good Soil
Zones 4-9**

This easy-to-grow perennial offers beautiful white, cup-shaped flowers surrounded by deep blue, spur-shaped petals in spring and early summer (May-June). Blooms emerge from attractive green foliage that turns maroon-colored in the fall. A favorite of butterflies, hummingbirds and cut-flower enthusiasts, these bell-shaped treasures dancing in the breeze are good companions to many flowers, particularly in natural plantings.



Columbine (Aquilegia) - Kirigami Mix

Height: 12-20”

Spread: 12-18”

**Part Sun or Light Shade, Good Soil
Zones 4-9**

This easy-to-grow perennial offers beautiful cup-shaped flowers surrounded by spur-shaped petals. It blooms in a variety of colors during spring and early summer (May-June). Blooms emerge from attractive green foliage that turns maroon-colored in the fall. A favorite of butterflies, hummingbirds and cut-flower enthusiasts, these bell-shaped treasures dancing in the breeze are good companions to many flowers, particularly in natural plantings.



Columbine McKana's Giants Mix

Height: 24-36"

Spread: 12-18"

Full Sun to Part Sun

Zones 3-9

McKana's Giants Mix provides nodding, long-spurred, bicolor flowers in red, pink and yellow shades, blooming over delicate, ferny foliage. Pollinators are attracted to the vibrant flowers in late spring to early summer. Deer and rabbit resistant, this columbine makes a gold plant for rock gardens or small spaces and tolerates average to moist sandy, loamy or acidic soil, as long as it is well-draining.



Coreopsis ‘Double the Sun’

Height 12-14”

Spread 14-16”

Full Sun

Zone 4-9

This early coreopsis (also known as “tickseed”) blooms in the first year with huge (2-1/2”), golden, semi-double flowers in a mound of bushy foliage. This long-blooming, deer resistant perennial tolerates dry soil and attracts butterflies. Its a great addition to the garden, border, bed, or in a container or as a focal point.



Coreopsis

“Moonbeam”

Height: 18-24 in.

Zones 4-9

Full Sun

This drought-tolerant Coreopsis works especially well in the front of the garden or in a rock wall. Pale yellow blooms glow all summer long atop delicate pinnate foliage. This plant enjoys regular moisture and well-drained soil. Long blooming time allows plenty of opportunities for pollinators to visit its glorious yellow flowers.



Coreopsis Sunkiss

Height 12-14” Zone 4-9

Spread 14-16”

Full Sun

Also known as “Tickseed”, Coreopsis Sunkiss forms a low mound of leathery green leaves giving rise to long-lasting single bright yellow daisy-like flowers with dark red-brown centers. This perennial tolerates heat and humidity without getting floppy and easily attracts butterflies.



Coreopsis Sunray

Height: 24”

Spread: 15-18”

Full Sun

Zones 3-10

Very floriferous, Coreopsis Sunray (Tickseed) is a compact perennial featuring a mound of bright golden-yellow two-inch diameter double flowers that bloom on two-foot tall stems over finely-divided dark green foliage for eight to twelve weeks through the summer.



Leucanthemum vulgare Filigran (Ox-Eye Daisy)

Height: 2-3'

Spread: 2-3'

Full to Part Sun

Zones 3-8

This Ox-Eye Daisy is robust and very flowery, producing an array of large, pure white, single daisy flowers with golden yellow centers, two inches across, over lush dark green leaves. Easy to grow, 'Filigran' blooms for up to four weeks from late spring to midsummer. Very adaptable, it enjoys average, dry to medium, well-drained soils, including clay, sand and loam. A perfect choice for perennial borders, meadows and cottage gardens.



Shasta Daisy

Height: 36-42”

Spread: 18-30”

Full Sun

Zone 4-9

The quintessential daisy, Shasta daisies sport large, single white flowers with bright yellow centers on strong, sturdy stems that hold up in wind and rain. Foliage is a deep, lustrous green and holds up well in heat and humidity. Shasta daisies also make excellent cut flowers.



Daylily ‘Fragrant Returns’

Height 18-20”

Spread 12-24”

Full to Part Sun

Zone 3-9

An American garden staple, ‘Fragrant Returns’ is one of the best yellow reblooming daylilies (so called because each flower usually lasts no more than a day, opening in the morning then withering that same night), producing an abundance of fragrant, 4” lemon-yellow flowers with ruffled, overlapping tepals. Relatively pest-free but attractive to butterflies and hummingbirds, ‘Fragrant Returns’ likes moist, well-drained soil.



Daylily 'Night Whispers'

Height 20-24"

Spread 24-28"

Full Sun

Zone 2-9

Sweetly fragrant, ruffled blooms make this extremely easy-to-grow re-blooming daylily a must-have for almost any summer garden. The abundance of blooms and color makes this variety a great addition to larger plantings and borders. Tolerant of any soil type and a range of light from full sun to part shade. Deer resistant.



Daylily 'Purple d'Oro'

Height: 14-20"

**Full Sun or AM Sun/PM Shade
Zones 3-9**

This reblooming daylily flowers all summer and into fall with showy magenta-purple blooms with chartreuse-yellow throats. One of the longest blooming daylilies, Purple d'Oro makes a perfect addition to a border, mixed bed or container. Beautiful, water-thrifty, easy-care, rabbit-resistant and pollinator-friendly, Purple d'Oro has it all!



Daylily ‘Strawberry Candy’

Height 22-26”

Spread 12-24”

Full Sun to Part Shade

Zone 3-9

This mid-season repeat bloomer features large (four-inch), ruffled-edged coral-to-rose-pink flowers with strawberry-red centers and yellow-green throats. Like other daylilies, ‘Strawberry Candy’ prefers full sun but will tolerate a variety of growing conditions, including a wide range of soil types. This easy-to-grow perennial attracts butterflies and hummingbirds while remaining rabbit resistant.



Delphinium Connecticut Yankee Mix

Height: 24-30”

Spread: 18-24”

Full Sun

Zones 2-9

This variety of delphinium is well-branched, more so than the more familiar spikier types. Plants form a low mound of deeply cut green leaves beneath upright bushy stems that bear lots of large, single, satiny two-inch flowers in a range of white, lavender and blue tones. This variety makes a long-lasting cut flower.



Delphinium Magic Fountain Mix

Height: 30-36"

Spread: 18-24"

Full Sun

Zones 2-9

This mid-sized delphinium series features strong stems with large spikes of flowers in shades of white, pink, blue, lilac and purple, sometimes with a contrasting center called a "bee". This variety serves well in the garden border or as a cut summer bloom.



Pacific Giant Delphinium 'Black Knight'

Height: 48-72"

Spread: 18-24"

Full Sun

Zones 2-9

Pacific Giant is an excellent large-flowered series for garden or cutting. 'Black Knight' bears deep violet blossoms with a black bee, the darkest delphiniums available.



Dianthus 'Sweet' PL Series Mix

Zones 3-9

With fragrant blooms and strong stems, this is the perennial Sweet William for the garden or for cutting. The mix includes shades of red, coral, pink, purple, white, and bicolor.



Dianthus 'Carthusianorum'

Height 30"

Width 12"

Full Sun

Zone 4-9

An excellent choice for the border, this tall, see-through perennial produces flat-topped clusters of six to eight fragrant bright pink flowers that attract pollinators from June through fall. Foliage is mounding and grass-like. Versatile in its soil preferences, as long as the soil drains well.



‘Plenty o’ Hot Pink’ Dianthus

A voluptuous plant covered with striking one-inch hot pink blooms over green foliage all summer into fall. Makes a great cut flower. Deer resistant.



‘Rockin’ Red’ Dianthus

Height: 20”

Zone 4

Lacy, deep red, scented, fully-branched flowers make this intense dianthus a truly spectacular plant. Three-inch flowers bloom in clusters from early spring well into fall. Durable performance, dependable overwintering, and long bloom time make ‘Rockin’ Red’ a great border plant that makes an outstanding contribution to beautiful bouquets.



Spring Beauty Mix Dianthus

Height: 18”

Spread: 12-36”

Full Sun to Part Shade

Zone 4

Fragrant, fringed, semi-double and double flowers in white to red shades bloom in the late spring of the plant’s first year. This variety works well for edging, in the front of the border, as a ground cover plant, for rock gardens or interplanted into rock walls.

Fragrant, rose-red flowers bloom all summer over mounding clumps of bright green leaves, forming a mat of showy color in an edge or on a slope, bank or rock wall in June or July. The cut flowers are perfect for small bouquets. This deer-resistant evergreen attracts butterflies. This dianthus prefers dry, loose, normal to alkaline, sandy soil.
