Echinacea Cheyenne Spirit

Height: 24-30”

Spread: 18-20”

Full Sun

Zones 2-9

This mixture provides flowers in a vibrant range of rich shades of orange, scarlet, rosy red, purple, cream, tomato red, and golden yellow atop sturdy stems in mid-summer.

Cheyenne Spirit is an exceptional bloomer and a vigorous, compact, well-branched, full plant.



Echinacea

PowWow White

Height: 24-36”

Spread: 12-18”

Full Sun to Part Shade

Zones 2-8

PowWow White is a four-inch daisy-like white coneflower with a yellow cone that typically grows in an upright clump on sturdy, well-branched stems. Flowers bloom from late spring to late summer, sometimes with sporadic blooms until frost. This echinacea is a great flower for massing in the border, meadow, wildflower or woodland garden along with Black-eyed Susans.



Echinacea PowWow Wild Berry

Height: 24-36”

Spread: 12-18”

Full Sun to Part Shade

Zones 2-8

PowWow Wild Berry features a floriferous bloom of large, deep rose-purple flowers from late spring to late summer, sometimes with sporadic blooms until frost. This echinacea usually grows in an upright clumps with sturdy, well-branched stems on which these striking three- to four-inch flowers are displayed.



Echinacea Prairie Splendor Deep Rose

Height: 16-20"

Spread: 6-8"

Part to Full Sun

Zones 2-9

Prairie Splendor Deep Rose flows in the first year, and its early blooming extends its flowering period. Large rose-pink flowers appear atop compact, well-branched stems. This deer-resistant perennial attracts butterflies and is beneficial for pollinators in general.



Echinacea Primadonna White

Height: 24-36”

Spread: 18-24”

Full Sun to Part Shade

Zones 2-8

Primadonna White is an upright, clump-forming, widely-branched, single white coneflower with sturdy stems that support large, daisy-like flowers in a floriferous bloom from late spring to late summer, sometimes with random blooms until frost.



Echinacea (Purple Coneflower)

Height: 1-5 ft.

Full Sun to Part Shade

Zone 3-9

Similar to black-eyed Susan, the purple coneflower is a herbaceous perennial plant that has strong, hairy stems that bear daisy-like flowers in shades of pink or purple with dark-purple centers. Grows best in moist, well-drained soil that contains organic matter, although they will grow in most kinds of soil. Purple coneflower sometimes tolerates wet soil and is drought-tolerant but does not grow as well in dry areas with full-sun exposure.



Echinops (Globe Thistle) Blue Glow

Height: 24-48”

Spread: 12-24”

Full Sun

Zones 3-8

Showy steel-blue flowers bloom in July and August on this erect, clump-forming perennial. Excellent for cutting, once they go to seed, finches find them very interesting. This thorny plant is easily grown in average, well-drained soil in full sun. It tolerates a wide range of soils, as long as they drain well.



Oenothera Silver Blade (Evening Primrose)

Height 4-8” Zone 4a-9
Width 16-24”
Full Sun

Endemic to the southern Great Plains, this plant’s silver leaves complement clear yellow flowers that bloom from May to frost. Oenothera Silver Blade is very drought tolerant and prefers well-drained soil. This deer-resistant perennial is friendly to pollinators.



Japanese Painted Fern (*Athyrium niponicum pictum*)

Height 12-18” Zone 3-8

Spread 18-24”

Part Shade to Full Shade

This gorgeous shade-preferring fern produces clumps of triangular, variegated fronds up to 20” long. They are a soft grayish-green with silverly hues accented by dark maroon midribs. Fronds produce their best color in light shade.



Red-stemmed Lady Fern ‘Lady in Red’

Height 24-36”

Spread 24-36”

Part to Full Shade

Zone 3-9

This variety of Northern Lady Fern features vibrant burgundy stems that contrast beautifully with lacy green fronds. (Rich stem color develops after the plant’s second season.) Easy to grow, ‘Lady in Red’ prefers rich, medium to wet, well-drained soil and makes a terrific ground cover or addition to a container or woodland garden.



Digitalis purpurea (Foxglove ‘Candy Mountain Rose’)

Height: 3-4’

Spread: 1-2’

Part to Full Sun

Zones 4-9

These beautiful, old-fashioned, biennial flowers that readily reseed themselves are excellent for backgrounds and cottage gardens. ‘Candy Mountain Rose’ is special because its bright rose-pink flowers with spotted throats bloom on very strong, upright stems and face upward, unlike those of other foxgloves, making them easily visible. *Note: Foxglove can be poisonous when consumed. It is best to wear gloves when handling foxglove and to plant it where it cannot be accessed by children and pets.*



Digitalis purpurea (Foxglove ‘Foxy’)

Height: 12-36”

Spread: 12”

Part to Full Sun

Zones 4-9

This special pastel color mix flowers in its first year from seed, sporting spikes of creamy-white, mauve and pink flowers with spotted throats that make extraordinary cut flowers. Easy to grow, foxglove is essential to cottage gardens and perennial borders. *Note: Foxglove can be poisonous when consumed. It is best to wear gloves when handling foxglove and to plant it where it cannot be accessed by children and pets.*



Fragrant Trumpet Lily 'Carbonero'

Height 36-38"

Spread 1'

Full Sun to Partial Shade

Zone 3-9

This lily is not only visually stunning with its magnificent large, silky, raspberry red blooms; its sweet scent drifts throughout the garden, creating an attractive and inviting atmosphere. No garden is complete without this gorgeous lily.



Fragrant Lily ‘Speedy’

Height 12-14”

Spread 10-16”

Full to Part Sun

Zone 4-9

Aptly named, ‘Speedy’ is one of the fastest lilies to bloom, producing clusters of large, fragrant pink flowers on short, stocky stems. This long-blooming plant prefers average soil and attracts hummingbirds and butterflies. It looks great in mass plantings and containers and makes an excellent cut flower.



Fragrant Lily ‘Stargazer’

Height 3-4’

Spread 1’

Full Sun to Partial Sun

Zone 4-9

These incredibly gorgeous lilies are easy to grow in moist, well-drained soil in full to partial sun. Slender stalks are topped with a cluster of large, exotic, fragrant, pink and white flowers. Tall enough for the back of the garden bed, they are sure to become a focal point, not just for butterflies and hummingbirds, but for human admirers as well.



Fragrant Trumpet Lily 'True Emotion'

Height 16-20"

Spread 1'

Full Sun to Partial Shade

Zone 3-9

'True Emotion' is a short, compact Oriental lily with fragrant, snow white flowers that stand out at dawn and dusk and look particularly spectacular when paired with foliage-rich plants. It can tolerate part shade and makes an excellent cut flower.



Gaillardia aristata

Burgundy

Height: 20-30”

Spread: 12-16”

Full Sun

Zones 3-10

This long bloomer forms a round, bushy plant covered in deep burgundy-red, short-rayed, coned flowers starting in June. Gaillardia thrives in dry soil and direct sun. It provides an early source of nectar for native insects, butterflies and bees, and provides late season nectar as well. Deer and rabbit resistant, it attracts butterflies all summer long. It is perfect for grouping in the middle or back of the garden.



Gaillardia ‘Goblin’

Height: 8-12”

Spread: 10-12”

Full Sun

Zones 2-9

Gaillardia (Blanket Flowers) are among the longest-blooming perennials and are well-suited to hot, sunny sites. This particular dwarf variety sports large crimson daisies whose petals are tipped in golden-yellow. ‘Goblin’ makes an amazing addition to edges, borders, rock gardens or containers. Flowers are attractive to butterflies and are excellent for cutting.



Gaillardia Mesa Custom Mix

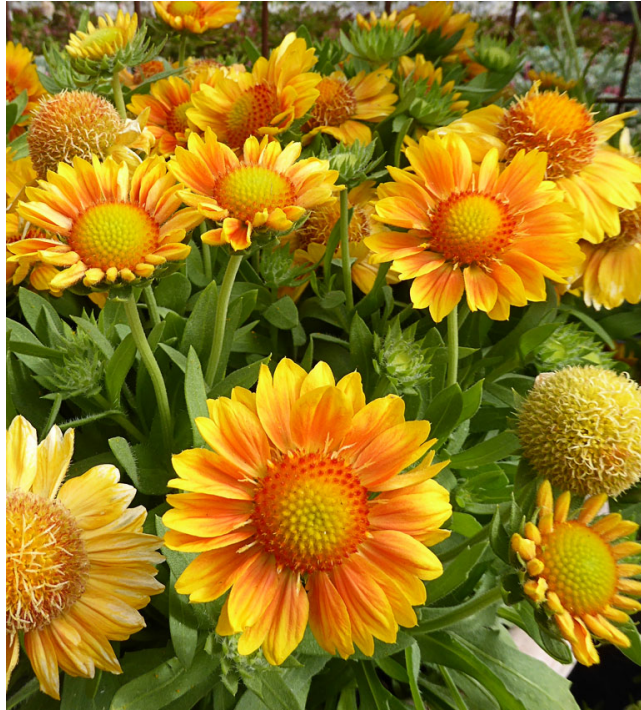

Zones 3-9

The Gaillardia grandiflora Mesa series features compact mounds of floriferous first-year blooms on a stout, drought-tolerant garden plant that is a favorite of butterflies.



Gaillardia Mesa Peach

Height 16-18”

Width 20-22”

Full Sun

Zone 3-9

Gaillardia Mesa Peach is a long-blooming blanket flower with golden peach flowers. This drought tolerant plant does well in dryer sections of the garden. Pollinators seem to love these gorgeous blooms!



Gaillardia Mesa Red

Height 16-18”

Width 20-22”

Full Sun

Zone 3-9

Gaillardia Mesa Red is a stout, drought-tolerant butterfly attractor. Reliably compact with highly uniform, no-flop first-year bloom, this long-lasting bloomer works great in a gallon pot.



Geranium Bloody Cranesbill*

Height 12-18”

Spread 18-24”

Full Sun to Part Shade

Zone 3-8

This plant forms a dense mound of lacy, dark green leaves that turn crimson in fall. Magenta flowers show up in early summer and bloom sporadically throughout the summer.



Geranium ‘Max Frei’ (Bloody Cranesbill)*

Height 8-12”

Spread 12-24”

Full Sun to Part Shade

Zone 3-8

This compact, clump-forming deciduous perennial shows off finely divided deep green leaves topped in late spring and early summer with bright magenta flowers. Foliage often turns blood-red in fall. ‘Max Frei’ makes a stunning ground cover when planted en masse. It’s deer and rabbit resistant and attractive to butterflies.



Rozanne Hybrid Cranesbill Geranium*

Height: 18-20"

Spread: 24-36"

Full Sun to Part Shade

Zone 4-8

This hybrid is one of the best hardy geraniums for perennial gardens. Two-and-a-half inch wide flowers in a striking shade of blue-violet with white centers start to bloom in late June and continue blooming into autumn. This spreading mound's foliage turns a lovely red-brown in the fall. The plant requires winter protection in Zone 4.



Aruncus sinensis x dioicus
Zweiweltenkind
(Goatsbeard)

Height: 24-36”

Spread: 18-24”

Full Sun to Part Shade

Zones 4-8

This compact goatsbeard is best grown in moist, fertile soil in full sun to part shade. It must not be allowed to dry out. Goatsbeard features pinnately compound dark green leaves and showy, plume-like spikes of tiny cream-colored flowers that stand well above the foliage in early to mid-summer. ‘Zweiweltenkind’ is perfect as a ground cover or edging.



Elymus canadensis ‘Icy Blue’ (Canada wild rye)

Height: 2-5 ft.

Spread: 2-3 ft.

Full Sun

Zone 3-8

Canada wild rye, sometimes called noddling wild rye, is a cool season, clump-forming native ornamental bunch grass known for its arching, wheat/rye-like spikes which bloom in summer and remain attractive well into winter. Tall clumps feature flat, pointed bluish-green to green leaves up to 3/4” wide. Greenish flowers appear in terminal, arching, bristly spikes up to 6” long which, when mature, gracefully nod and sway in the wind on stiff stems rising well above the foliage. Foliage and spikes turn tan in fall and continue to provide visual interest throughout much of winter.



Elijah Blue Fescue

Height: 6-8 in.

Spread: 8-12 in.

Full Sun

Zone 3-8

Small, 6” to 8” tall perennial grass with attractive, fine-textured metallic blue foliage. A cool season grass hardy in Zone 4, grown primarily for the foliage. Clump-forming foliage may brown out during hot spells but revives with the onset of cooler weather.



Heliopsis ‘Sunstruck’ (False Sunflower)

Height: 14-16”

Spread: 12-14”

Full Sun

Zones 4-9

A North American native, ‘Sunstruck’ sports variegated foliage that forms a compact, mounded habit over which bright yellow blooms resembling small sunflowers burst all summer long. Heliopsis needs moderately fertile, well-drained soil which does not dry out during the summer.



Heuchera ‘Marvelous Marbles Silver’

Height: 8-12”

Spread: 16”

Full Sun to Full Shade

Zones 3-9

This Coral Bells variety offers a change of color throughout the seasons. In spring, new foliage emerges purple, then matures to deep green with prominent red-purple veins and a light silver overlay. Flower stems are quite short and bear creamy white flowers a bit earlier than most heucheras. This low, mounding plant serves well in containers or as edging along paths.



Heuchera 'Palace Purple'

Height: 12-24"

Spread: 12-18"

Full Sun to Part Shade

Zones 4-9

This clump-forming perennial features a basal mound of maple- or ivy-shaped leaves in an attractive deep purple above and beet-red below. Leaves may fade to bronze-green in hot summers. Small, pinkish-white bell-shaped flowers arise on slender, wiry stems and attract pollinators. Works well in the perennial border, rock garden, woodland garden or shade garden. Also makes an attractive ground cover. Best grown in rich, well-drained soil.



Hibiscus 'Disco Belle' Mix

Height 24-32"

Spread 20-24"

Full Sun

Zone 4-9

This gorgeous compact hibiscus sports huge, dinner-plate sized flowers over bushy green foliage. Disco Belle is perfect for big color in smaller spaces. Plants in this mix may bloom in pink, rosy red or white. Disco Belle prefers rich wet to moist soils, but also tolerates clay, muck and shallow standing water and is fairly drought tolerant once established.



Honeysuckle

Dropmore Scarlet

Height: 8-12 ft.

Spread: 6 ft.

Full Sun to Part Shade

Zones 4-9

Dropmore Scarlet is a vigorous climber with masses of stunning tubular scarlet flowers with orange throats that bloom from June to September and eventually give way to small, bright red berries. This honeysuckle can happily cover a 10-12 foot wall, fence or pergola for a striking floral display. Preferring partial shade, this plant is best grown in fertile, rich, moist, well-drained soil. Prune in late winter or early spring.



‘Major Wheeler’ Honeysuckle

Height: 3-8 ft.

Sun to Part Shade

Zones 3-8

‘Major Wheeler’ features coral-red trumpet-like flowers with golden insides against medium green viny foliage. Blooms appear from late spring to autumn. Choose this variety to cover a trellis, fence or stone wall. It is easy to grow in average, moist soil.



Hosta 'Blue Mountains'

Height **20-32"**

Spread **24-28"**

Full to Partial Shade

Zone 3-9

One of the best blue hosts with intense, attractive blue-gray puckered, heart-shaped leaves with large white flowers. Blooms in summer. Winter hardy. Deer resistant. Good container plant. Easy to grow in various soil conditions.



Hosta 'Blue Mouse Ears'

Height 8-12"

Spread 12"

Partial Shade to Full Shade

Zone 2-9

This adorable little hosta sports thick blue-green leaves resembling mouse ears in a tiny compact mound over which lily-like lavender flowers rise. It requires protection from the hot afternoon sun and likes well-drained soil. With good slug resistance, this hosta is perfect for edging or for a shady rock garden and is a must for small gardens!



Hosta 'Fire & Ice'

Height **12-22"**

Spread **12-24"**

Partial Sun to Full Shade

Zones 2-9

This hosta's broad leaves are pure white with dark green margins. It produces lavender flowers on white stems in July/August. Any sun it prefers comes gently and in the morning, and it is easily grown in evenly moist, organically rich, well-drained soils that are never allowed to dry out. Hostas are a mainstay of any shade garden, and this variety is truly eye-catching.



Hosta 'Firn Line'

Height 8-10"

Spread 24"

Partial Sun to Full Shade

Zones 3-9

'Firn Line' has heart-shaped blue-green leaves with wide margins that start the season in shades of pale yellow and quickly turn to pure white. The color contrast in the leaves is eye-catching and looks great in moonlight as well as daylight. This small hosta's lavender flowers attract hummingbirds in mid-summer. This slug-resistant variety tolerates most soil types, as long as they drain well.



Hosta 'Paul's Glory'

Height **21-25"**

Spread **36-48"**

Partial Sun to Full Shade

Zones 2-9

'Paul's Glory' has lightly corrugated heart-shaped leaves with wide dark blue-green edges and chartreuse centers that darken to gold. Nearly-white lavender flowers appear in July and attract hummingbirds. This variety does best with some sun and prefers rich, acid-to-neutral, moist but well-drained soil. Like all hostas, 'Paul's Glory' works well in beds and borders and for underplanting roses and shrubs.



Hosta 'Royal Standard'

Height 24-36"

Spread 36-48"

Partial Sun to Full Shade

Zones 2-9

'Royal Standard' produces large mounds of glossy, veined, sun-resistant green leaves and fragrant white flowers that appear in August. Vigorous and fast-growing, this sun-to-part-shade lover is best grown in rich, moist, slightly acidic or neutral well-draining soil. This variety is quite sun tolerant as long as it has adequate moisture, and its leaves will turn chartreuse in full sunlight. It needs protection from cold, dry winds.
