Jacob's Ladder 'Blue Pearl'

Height 12-18"

Spread 12-15"

Part Sun to Light Shade

Zones 3-9

Loose clusters of small blue flowers bloom on well-branched erect stems in late spring and early summer. With average water needs, 'Blue Pearl' is easy to grow in moist, humus-rich, well-drained soil and works well in garden beds, massed plantings, borders and woodland gardens. It makes a beautiful companion for spring bulbs and hostas.



Jacob's Ladder 'Touch of Class'

Height: 14-18"

Spread: 12-18"

Full Sun to Part Shade

Zones 3-9

This wonderful component plant has striking grey-green foliage variegated with bright white edges and pink buds that open to small, pale blue flowers. Jacob's Ladder likes evenly moist soil and some protection from the hot afternoon sun.



Eupatorium ‘Pink Frost’ (Joe Pye Weed)

Height 30-36”

Spacing 24-36”

Full Sun to Half Sun

Zone 4-8

This Joe Pye Weed is not only a great foliage accent; it’s easier to care for than it’s completely green relatives. It has the same tall shape and late-summer pink flower, but its leaves are edge in cream and white. This perennial attracts butterflies and is beneficial for pollinators. It is also tolerant of deer and wet soils.



Lady's Mantle 'Thriller'

Height 1-2'

Spread 1-2'

Full Sun to Part Shade

Zone 3-7

Lady's Mantle forms a basal foliage mound of long-stalked, scallop-edged, pleated, fuzzy green leaves that sparkle when holding raindrops and morning dew. (They're said to be a favorite of the faeries!) Glorious clusters of sweet yellow flowers appear on stems rising above the foliage to 12-18" in late spring to early summer.



Lamb's Ear 'Silky Fleece'

Height 6-12"

Spread 6-12"

Sun

Zone 5-9

This versatile dwarf Lamb's Ear tolerates rabbits, deer, dry soil, shallow or rocky soil and poor air quality. Purple flowers bloom in July or August. This rugged little plant enjoys dry conditions and is lovely along walkway edges and stones. Plus, the Faeries are big fans, and the silvery leaves are really, really soft!



Larkspur

Height: 12-36"

Spread: 6-18"

Part to Full Sun

Zones 2-10

Larkspur, the common name for a group of flowering perennials in the genus *Delphinium*, is a member of the buttercup family. Flowers come in a variety of colors, including blue, lavender, white and red. Lobed leaves are silvery-green, and tall flower spikes make desirable cut flowers. Larkspur is a classic cottage garden staple that adds gracefulness to any green space, whether planted in masses or mixed with other perennials and annuals.



Lavender 'Phenomenal'

Height **24-32"**

Sun

Zone 4-8

One of the hardiest lavenders, 'Phenomenal' sports uniform and consistent silverly foliage. It has a nice round form and a high oil (and thus fragrance) content. Very low winter dieback.



Liatris (Blazing Star)

Height: 2-4 ft.

Spread: 9-18 in.

Zones 3-8

Full Sun



This member of the aster family is native to the Eastern U.S. While drought tolerant, it prefers rich, moist soil. This tall, upright, clump-forming perennial features 6- to 12-inch terminal spikes sporting rounded, fluffy flower heads atop leafy stalks that stand above grass-like foliage. This showy late summer bloomer effortlessly attracts bees, butterflies and other pollinators.



Lobelia cardinalis (Cardinal Flower)

Height 1-6'

Spread 1-2'

Full Sun to Part Shade

Zone 3-9

This beautiful native plant, often seen along streams, is easily grown in rich, medium to wet soils in full sun to part shade. It needs constant moisture and thus should never be allowed to dry out. Cardinal flower's bright red blooms over bright green foliage put on a spectacular midsummer show.



Raspberry Splash Lungwort

Height: 12” Zone 3-9

Spread: 12-15”

Exposure: Shade

Silver speckles adorn sharply-pointed foliage that hosts small, raspberry/coral-colored, bell-shaped flowers that arrive in May. With a somewhat upright growth habit, this lungwort is an excellent addition to hostas, ferns and astilbe in a shade garden.



Mallow

Height: 3-8'

Part to Full Sun

Zones 3-8

Mallow is an easy-to-grow, short-lived perennial in the same family as hollyhock. Small blossoms are held aloft on tall stems over softly-lobed, kidney-shaped foliage. Mallow looks great mixed among larger shrubs and other perennials. Once planted, mallow tends to self-seed for years of continuous bloom. Mallow is also known as “cheese weed” thanks to its flat, button-like seed pods that look like tiny wheels of cheese!



Maltese Cross

Height **36-48” Zone 2-9**

Spread **12-18”**

Full Sun

Maltese Cross is a rugged and easy perennial that works beautifully in a sunny border. Upright clumps of bright green leaves give rise to large clusters of scarlet-orange flowers that attract butterflies and hummingbirds.



Monarda (Bee Balm) **“Bee-You™ Bee-Free”**

Height: 15-18 in.

Zones 4-9

Full Sun

This bee balm provides a globe of rich purple flowers in summer. Even before it blooms, bracts take on an attractive purple stain that sometimes returns with the cool temperatures of fall. This summer bloomer is a special favorite among bees and other pollinators. Also called wild bergamot, bee balm is a native North American member of the mint family.



Monarda (Bee Balm) 'Jacob Cline'

Height: 60"

Sun

Zone 3-8

Jacob Cline's large red flowers bloom from June through August. It requires rich, consistently moist, well-drained soil and is mildew resistant. Deadheading prolongs bloom time.



Nepeta 'Walker's Low'

Height 18-24"

Spread 24"

Sun to Part Shade

Zone 3-8

This long-blooming cultivar sports showy lavender-blue flowers over grey-green, catmint-scented foliage from April until frost. It forms compact mounds that spread vigorously to about two feet wide. This pollinator favorite is often abuzz with bees!



Nepeta parnassica (Greek Catmint)

Height 4'
Spread 2-3'
Sun to Part Shade
Zone 4-8

This impressive plant boasts delightfully aromatic violet-blue flowers that bloom in the first year. A butterfly attractor, Greek Catmint makes a strong statement in a border in both sun and part shade.



Penstemon 'Dark Towers'

Height: 33-36"

Spread: 30"

Full Sun

Zones 3-8

Dark Towers possesses dark foliage that emerges wine-purple with masses of pale pink tubular flowers that extend above it in early to midsummer. This perennial adds rich color to the perennial border or to mixed beds and goes especially well with lavender. It also tolerates heat and humidity well. Pollinators, especially hummingbirds, love it!



Garden Peony 'Karl Rosenfield'

Height: 32-38"

Full Sun

Zone 3-8

Large, red, double blooms are spectacularly displayed on sturdy, erect stems emerging from beautiful, lush, green foliage on a rounded form. A truly exquisite cut flower.



Garden Peony 'Sarah Bernhardt'

Height: 24-36"
Spread: 24-30"
Sun
Zone 3-8

Shrubby clumps of green foliage support this large, showy, fragrant flower, which opens as mid-spring slides into the end of spring.



Phlox paniculata ‘Blue Paradise’

Height 2-4’

Spacing 20”

Full Sun

Zone 4-8

‘Blue Paradise’ provides a profusion of purple-blue flowers with a small white center. The fragrant flowers deepen with age and are more blue in morning and evening light, appearing more lilac in midday sun. The strong, lush foliage is very mildew resistant. This long-blooming plant attracts butterflies and hummingbirds.



Phlox ‘Candy Store® Bubblegum Pink™’

Height: 18-22”

Spread: 12-24”

Sun

Zones 3-9

‘Candy Store® Bubblegum Pink™’ is a shorter phlox that is unlikely to flop. It is well-branched and covered in bright pink flowers. This phlox has both a long bloom time and a high resistance to powdery mildew.



Phlox ‘Fashionably Early Princess’

Height: 28-32”

Full Sun

Zone 4-8

Light fuchsia flowers bloom two to three weeks earlier than typical Phlox. Thick, glossy green foliage has excellent mildew resistance.



Phlox “Flame[®] Coral”

Height: 16-20 in.

Zones 3-8

Full Sun

With its large clusters of fragrant, coral-red flowers that bloom in midsummer above compact green foliage, Garden Phlox is often considered the “backbone” of the perennial border. While most plants are taking a nap during the hottest days of summer, Flame[®] Coral Phlox provides a welcome burst of color. Butterflies and hummingbirds can’t resist its delectable blooms!



Phlox ‘Jeana’

Height: 48-60”

Spread: 24-36”

Full Sun to Part Shade

Zone 4-8

A tall garden phlox, ‘Jeana’ is a must-have for the pollinator garden. Native to Tennessee, ‘Jeana’ has natural resistance to powdery mildew. It produces large masses of small lavender-pink flowers from July to October. Its sweet, spicy fragrance is very attractive to butterflies. Because ‘Jeana’ is so tall, it is well suited for the back of the border.



Phlox 'Laura'

Height: 36-48"

Full Sun

Zone 4-8

Huge panicles of fragrant pink-purple flowers bloom from July to September. Each floret has a distinct white star in its center. This Phlox is very mildew resistant. Plant it in rich, moist, well-drained soil and deadhead it to prolong its blooming season.



Oriental Poppy ‘Brilliant’

Height: 24-36”

Spread: 24”

Full Sun

Zone 3-7

Clumps of ferny foliage support translucent blooms of brilliant wildfire red with deep color at the base of the petals. They arrive in early summer and stick around until it gets too hot, then they produce interesting seedpods. Prefers loose soils, sandy or rocky, with excellent drainage. Deer resistant and excellent support for pollinators, including hummingbirds, bees and butterflies.
