# **Rudbeckia triloba**

**Height: 24-36”**

**Spread: 12-18”**

**Full Sun**

**Zones 4-8**

**This brown-eyed Susan sports a multitude of small, golden-yellow flowers with rich brown centers. It**

**is a coarse, weedy, somewhat hairy, densely-branched biennial. It does well in average, or even poor, soil.**

**Deadheading spent flowers encourages additional blooming and prevents unwanted self-seeding.**



## **Rudbeckia triloba - Blackjack Gold**

**Height 36-40”**

**Spread 18-24”**

**Full Sun**

**Zone 3-8**

**This well-branched Black-Eyed Susan cultivar sports round gold blooms with a dark eye. Flowers are long-lived and bloom throughout late summer and fall. This Rudbeckia attracts both birds and butterflies and is resistant to both deer and rabbits. It has low to moderate water needs and is drought tolerant once established. It handles most types of soils as long as they are well-draining.**



# **Perovskia Blue Steel (Russian Sage)**

**Height: 3-5'**

**Spread: 3-5'**

**Full Sun**

**Zones 4-9**

**Aromatic silvery foliage carries clouds of airy, lavender-blue flowers on strong silver stems. Adored by butterflies and hummingbirds, this great backdrop plant performs well in heat and drought as it provides cool color to the garden through late summer.**



# **Salvia nemerosa**

## **“Merleau<sup>®</sup> White”**

**Height 12-14”    Zone 4-8**

**Width 6-10”**

**Full Sun to Part Shade**

**Merleau is a first-year flowering winter hardy salvia. It is compact, well-branched and bushy, and it produces upright stems of white flowers, which are attractive to bees and butterflies. Plants may repeat bloom throughout the summer as long as they get the moisture they require to do so. Perfect for bed and border fronts, cottage gardens, edging and containers.**



# **Salvia nemerosa**

## **“Blue Marvel”**

**Zone 4-9**

**Full Sun**

**Water regularly**

**This deer- and rabbit-resistant salvia is particularly compact and looks stunning in borders. Flower spikes are covered with vivid, violet-blue blooms atop grey-green stems in a dense, shrub-like habit. This herbaceous perennial also makes a wonderful bedding or container plant.**



## **Salvia nemerosa “Caramia”**

**Height 14-16”**

**Spread 14-16”**

**Zone 3-9**

**Full Sun**

**Salvia are invaluable perennials for their rich display in borders. Plants form a bushy clump of grey-green leaves from which emerge upright spikes of dark purple flowers in early summer, just in time for the butterflies and hummingbirds who love them.**



## **Salvia nemerosa** **“Violet Queen”**

**Height 18”**

**Zone 4-9**

**Spacing 15”**

**Full Sun**

**“Violet Queen” blooms in early summer with numerous spikes of dark violet flowers on bushy plants. It goes with almost everything in the garden, but makes an especially nice companion plant for roses. This hardy perennial is drought tolerant and easy to grow, and it attracts both hummingbirds and butterflies.**



# **Salvia superba**

## **“Rose Queen”**

**Height 20” Zone 4-8**

**Spacing 16”**

**Full Sun to Mostly Sunny**

**Multiple spikes of rose-pink flowers appear on arching colorful stems in midsummer. Rose Queen sports aromatic, lance-shaped, mid-green foliage. This variety blooms in the first year, tolerates drought, and pairs beautifully with bright yellow Coreopsis and Achillea (yarrow). Rose Queen also attracts butterflies and is beneficial for pollinators.**





## **Scabiosa ‘Flutter’ - Rose Pink (Pincushion Flower)**

**Height: 12-14”**

**Spread: 10-12”**

**Full Sun**

**Zones 5-9**

**This compact, short-stemmed variety produces tufted 3-4” flowers that appear to be stuck with pins. This plant excels in cooler climates and blooms all season long. An excellent choice for cutting, scabiosa also appeals to butterflies and hummingbirds, but not to deer. Great for mass plantings, rock gardens or small spaces, scabiosa tolerates a range of soils from dry to average, as long as they drain well.**



# **Sedum 'Autumn Charm'**

**Height: 12-18"**

**Spread: 12-18"**

**Full Sun**

**Zone 4-8**

**This sedum shows off blue-green foliage with creamy leaf margins topped with bright pink flowers that age to deep red and do not revert. Between its foliage and its flowers, 'Autumn Charm' is truly a spectacular plant all season long.**



# **Sedum 'Matrona'**

**Height: 24-36"**

**Spread: 18-24"**

**Full Sun**

**Zone 3-9**

**This upright sedum shows off blue-green foliage enhanced by dark red stems. Pretty pink flower heads appear in July and August. Between its foliage and its flowers, 'Matrona' is truly a spectacular plant all season long.**



# **Sedum ‘Red Cauli’**

**Height            8-12”**

**Spacing           12”**

**Full Sun to Mostly Sunny**

**Zone 3-9**

**Sedum are notable for their unique fleshy foliage. ‘Red Cauli’ features red stems and burgundy leaves under prolific flower clusters that open pink and quickly darken to a nearly true red. This upright perennial prefers full sun but isn’t too particular about soil.**



## **Saponaria ocymoides 'Snow Tip' (Rock Soapwort)**

**Height: 6-8"**

**Spread: 12-24"**

**Full Sun**

**Zones 2-9**

**Rock Soapwort is a vigorous, low creeping plant that is perfect for trailing down sunny slopes or over rock walls or as an edging in the sunny border. It forms a low mound of bright green leaves covered by starry white flowers in late spring. This fast-growing evergreen tolerates dry, normal or sandy soils and is drought tolerant once established.**



## **‘Sweet Kate’ Spiderwort**

**Height 9-12” Zone 4-9**

**Width 9-12”**

**Full Sun to Part Shade**

**Excellent for a rain garden, this plant, with its showy purple flowers against yellow-green foliage, tolerates wet soil. Blooming from May to July, this spiderwort grows easily in full sun to part shade.**



# Swamp Milkweed

**Height**      4-5'  
**Spread**      1 - 2'  
**Sun**  
**Zone** 3-6

**This native swamp milkweed presents small, fragrant pink to mauve flowers that look great in vases! Swamp milkweed blooms from July to August and thrives in medium to wet soil. Monarch butterflies love this variety just as much as the common milkweed we find in fields and along roads. Perhaps you'll attract your very own monarch butterfly caterpillar!**



## **Tiarella Pink Skyrocket (Foam Flower)**

**Height: 6-12”**

**Spread: 10-12”**

**Shade to Part Shade**

**Zone 4-9**

**Pink Skyrocket is one of the pinkest flowering Tiarellas available. In spring, large quantities of shrimp-pink foam flowers rocket upward from deeply cut foliage. Tiarella’s interest continues beyond spring when its leaves deepen to bronze or black in the fall depending on light conditions.**





## **Tricyrtis Seiryu (Toad Lily)**

**Height: 18-24”**

**Spread: 18-24”**

**Shade to Part Shade**

**Zone 4-8**

**Be sure to plant this beauty up close in the shade in a spot where its unique flowers can be appreciated. White orchid-like flowers with deep purple spots at the base deepen to light lavender-blue at the petal tips and are great for cutting. These unusual blooms appear on long, arching stems over dark green spotted foliage in fall.**



## **Veronica spicata (Royal Candles Speedwell)**

**Height 10-12”    Zone 3-8**

**Width 12-15”**

**Full Sun**

**Veronica ‘Royal Candles’ is an outstanding upright growing Speedwell with long-blooming spikes of deep purple-blue flower against large, attractive deep-green leaves.**

**Both deer- and rabbit-resistant, this easy-to-grow plant attracts butterflies and is good for cut flower bouquets.**



# Virginia Bluebells

**Height: 18-24"**

**Spread: 12-18"**

**Part to Full Shade**

**Zone 3-8**

**This one- to two-foot tall clump-forming perennial loves shade and moist soils. A very early bloomer (April, sometimes March!), Virginia Bluebells features loose clusters of dangling trumpet-shaped flowers that bloom in early spring. Buds start off pink before turning blue. Leaves are smooth, oval and bluish-green and die back to the ground by mid-summer as the plant goes dormant (so, no, you didn't kill it by June!).**



## **Yellow Loosestrife 'Alexander'**

**Height 2-3' Zone 4-8**

**Spread 2-3'**

**Full Sun or Partial Sun**

**'Alexander' is a stunning ornamental perennial with sturdy, upright stems sporting striking cream-edged, lime green variegated foliage. They emerge blushing pink in spring and age to white. Flowers are cup-shaped and golden yellow, with a hint of red at their center. They bloom from early to late summer. Easy to tend, 'Alexander' is a butterfly favorite!**
