



planning to replace the fence around the driver's education lot and implement extra security procedures.


- Taft student Zoe Nance, playing for Dunham Park, will represent her country and community at an inaugural girls baseball world series tournament in Japan in August.

Aerie--Not Just a Yearbook



Aeries—bald eagle nests—are generally 5 feet wide and 3 feet deep—about the size of an average hot tub. They are typically built in the tallest conifers near their sturdy trunks. While both parents construct a nest, the female is said to perform most of the placement of branches, twigs, and soft materials. The largest recorded aerie, found in St. Petersburg, FL, measured 9.5 feet in diameter, 20 feet deep and weighed almost 6,000 pounds! The ranger above sits in a replica aerie found at Hueston Woods State Park in Ohio.
