

Norwood Park Historical Society



Located only two blocks from the Taft High School varsity campus, the Norwood Park Historical Society is headquartered in the historic 1833 Noble-Seymour-Crippen House, Chicago's oldest house. The Society maintains a museum and, as part of its mission, seeks to develop and maintain historical archives related to Norwood Park.

Who better than the Taft Alumni Association to assist with the expansion of our archival collection? Since the Taft High School opening in 1939, the students and alumni have been an integral part of the Norwood Park community and have been both eyewitnesses to and participants in local history.

The connection between Taft alumni and the NPHS archives became obvious recently while a Society volunteer was researching the World War II community effort to raise \$500,000 in war bond sales to purchase a hospital plane. The plane would be named *The Spirit of Norwood Park*. Within one week the total amount was raised. Taft and the other local schools participated in a slogan contest for the "Flying Hospital Campaign."


An online search for additional information produced a link to the TAA newsletter published in the Autumn of 2002. In a "Letter to the Editor" an alum recounted biking to Higgins and Mannheim to watch the new Douglas airplanes like The Spirit of Norwood Park roll out of the factory. He further recounted being in the crowd of hundreds for the unveiling of a mural of the plane on a building at Northwest Highway and Raven. This type of community memory is invaluable to the effort of preserving the history of Norwood Park.


