# Leonard Wislow Donates Permanent Lights for "Friday Night Lights"

The following press release announced welcome news:

William Howard Taft High School, Chicago - Taft High School is looking forward to a return of "Friday Night Lights" on September 3, 2021, when it hosts Grant Community High School in a game that will include a halftime salute to military veterans.

The September 3 game, which starts at 7:30 p.m., will be Taft's third-ever Friday night home varsity football game, although one of those games had limited fans during the abbreviated spring season in 2021. Taft's multi-purpose sports field was installed in 2019 at Taft's Varsity Campus (6530 W Bryn Mawr Ave) with spectator stands but no lights. Prior to the 2019-2020 school year Taft's "home" football games had to be played off-site. Leonard Wislow, a 1966 Taft graduate, sponsored temporary lights for the first ever night game hosted on campus at Taft on September 6, 2019. A crowd of about 2,000 attended the game, during which Taft defeated Gwendolyn Brooks College Prep Academy.

Prior to Mr. Wislow's sponsorship of the temporary lights he also made past donations to Taft's weight room and athletic training room, which are named after him. Additionally, Mr. Wislow donated a grand piano to help mark the opening of the Taft Freshman Academy (4071 N. Oak Park Ave) in 2019. Following the success of the first game under temporary lights, Mr. Wislow, and his wife Gaye (Taft class of 1967) donated an additional \$300,000.00 for the installation of permanent lights at Taft's multipurpose sports field.

# No Hitter Remembered

Encouraged and recommended by my brother Greg, Taft R.O.T.C. Battalion Commander, (Jan '60) and sanctioned by his wife, Mary, Taft Cheerleader, (Jun '62) I will take their lead, and expand on my no hitter, during July of 1955! Whoo Hoo, here we go again! In my junior and senior years at Taft, I was part of the baseball team. Coached by one of the greatest baseball minds in high school athletics. Did you know he was a backup catcher for the Brooklyn Dodgers at one time? We were all fortunate to be a part of his team. He was a quiet no nonsense coach, but we all listened intently.

Anyway, back to pitching during July 1955, I was part of a summer team at the local Chicago Park District in Oriole Park. Most were neighborhood guys and were Taft students or graduates.

I believe we played 6-8 games per summer, plus playoffs. On the day of the no hitter, I struck out 9 and walked 4, but the real play of the game came, when their hitter in the last inning grounded a slow roller to our second baseman, Kenny Wirth (Jun '56), who back handed the ball, threw out the runner, saved the no hitter, and we won the game--hot dog, no pun intended.

The following year, the same team, we got to the playoffs thanks to Wally Guyer (Jan '55) who was on first, and a long single by a teammate, Wally scored from first and we beat the guys from Taft-- my teammates at Taft! Needless to say, I was clobbered at the quarter finals at Portage Park. I miss the camaraderie of those times! Let's play two!

I forgot to mention the coach's name--JIM SMILGOFF!
