MOVE UPS

Move-ups will be offered between trials, same day move ups are allowed. Move ups from Saturday to Sunday must be submitted before the end of the trial on Saturday! No run order adjustments/move ups will be made Sunday morning! Moved up dogs will run last on Saturday.

DOG ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

This trial is open to all dogs SIX (6) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP), an AKC Canine Partners listing number or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds are eligible to participate. Dogs with a Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number must be spayed or neutered in order to compete.

Condition of the Dog. Dogs with physical challenges(including amputees) are eligible to participate provided that, in the opinion of the judge, they display no signs of physical discomfort and can safely complete the search. Dogs with bandages, sutures, or visible wounds are not eligible. Deaf dogs and blind dogs are allowed to enter. Dogs that are both deaf and blind are able to participate so long as the handler is in control of the dog at all times, the dog can complete the requirements of the class, and the dog does not appear to be under undue stress in the opinion of the judge.

No entries will be accepted by phone, email, fax, or hand delivery. Express mail entries must include the signature waiver allowing them to be left at the secretary's address - signature required entries will be rejected. Inquiries may be directed to Andrea Defibaugh at heyjudetrialsec@gmail.com. No entry shall be made, and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance.

UPS and FedEx entries will not be accepted as they cannot deliver to a PO box.

Illegible entries will not be processed and will be shredded. Returned/bounced checks do not constitute a valid entry and will incur \$50.00 collection fee.

Entries not admitted to the trial and withdrawn entries will be shredded; not be returned to the exhibitor. If you want your payment method returned in the event of withdrawal, please include a self addressed, stamped envelope with your entry!

Please do not staple your entries and checks together.

DO NOT USE OLD ENTRY FORMS OR OAKLINES.

WAIT LIST INFORMATION

A wait list of 50 runs per trial will be maintained until the wait list closing date listed on page 1, after which time, no changes, alterations, substitutions, or backfills will be made to the trial entry list. Any runs not admitted to the trial by the Wait List Close Date above will be refunded.

CLOSING DATE. No entries may be withdrawn with a refund after closing. All entries must be received by trial closing. If a withdrawn entry is replaced by a wait listed entry, a full refund will be issued for the withdrawn entry. Any wait listed entry that does not move off the wait list into the trial will receive a full refund. If you do not wish to commit to a run you must withdraw from the wait list before trial closing.

Withdraw/Wait List updates will conclude October 23, 2026, 5 pm.

STAGING AREA, HANDLER'S BRIEFING, AND WARM-UP INFORMATION

Staging Area will be out of view of search area(s). Staging area will include crating, warm-up and waiting area, as well as the secretary table for check-ins and posting of running order and results.

The **Handler's Briefing** will take place in view of the search area prior to the start of each class, after the hide(s) have been set and after the Demo Dog has run. In the Handler's Briefing the judge will explain if there's an off-leash option, number of hides, maximum height of hides and maximum time for the search. **NO DOGS** are to be present during the Handler's Briefing.

Warm-up area: The club shall designate a warm-up area. One labeled container per target odor being used in the trial on that day will be placed in the warm-up area. This will allow handler-dog teams to prepare themselves for the search prior to their run. Each team should limit their warm-up to two minutes or less so that others may be able to use the warm-up area as well. Clubs may also place blank containers.

SEARCH AREA AND RING CONDITIONS

Search areas may be of any shape, and of the size specified in the Regulations for each class.

Search Area Conditions: Searches may be indoors, on matted, carpeted, hardwood, concreted, tarped, or tiled surfaces, or outdoors on grass, gravel, earth, concrete, or asphalt surfaces.

Search Area Sizes will be as specified in AKC Scent Work regulations.

ADDITIONAL SITE INFORMATION

Trial Site: It is not appropriate to visit the trial location prior to the trial date. Many search locations are real-life environments and such visits may risk the host losing the opportunity to use the location in the future. Exhibitors may encounter stairs as part of a search area or in general navigation of the site.

Potty Area will be designated at the morning general briefing. Signage will be posted. **Exhibitors are responsible for using appropriate potty area and cleaning up after their dog(s).** Any exhibitor failing to do so may be excused without benefit of refund if the Event Committee deems the exhibitor to be in violation of this requirement. Cleaning supplies and disposal sites will be available at various locations around the show grounds.

Restrooms for exhibitors will be designated at the morning general briefing. There will be signage for restrooms in each building. Some restrooms may be temporarily closed due to searches and an announcement will be made if the need for that occurs.

Possession of Odors and Training: Chapter 5. Section 35 of the Scent Work Regulations state "No person other than those engaged in the administration of a trial shall be in possession of any target odor when on the trial grounds. There shall be no training on the grounds of the AKC Scent Work trial, other than the designated warm-up area".

Spectator Area: Reasonable accommodation will be made for spectators. Any person not handling a dog in the current class, or any person who has already completed their run in the class may choose to watch the search from the spectator area. Handlers may not watch other exhibitors from their class prior to their run. No one outside the search area may assist the handler or disclose the location of the hide. Spectators who intentionally or unintentionally give aid to a team may be asked to leave the area by the judge. Spectators are forbidden to discuss details of the search area with anyone until the completion of the class.

Crating space Crating will be from your car; there are trees to park under and there may be limited crating space under the pavilion, all crates will need to be removed from the pavilion at the end of each day. **EXHIBITORS ARE NOT TO LEAVE ANYTHING OVERNIGHT.**

Parking: Ample parking is available, no RV hook-ups available, but RVs are allowed in separate parking to run generators. No overnight parking. There will be daytime only designated parking for RVs; please follow the signs for parking. Additional parking information will be included in the Trial Chair's Welcome Letter.

Smoking and Alcohol: The venue is a smoke and alcohol free facility. Smoking/vaping **IS NOT** allowed on the grounds for the safety and comfort of all participants and dogs.

Food and Concessions: Exhibitors should bring their own lunch, snacks, and beverages if desired. There are a few restaurants and convenience stores within reasonable driving distance.

While not actively searching, dogs MUST be on a fixed length 6' or shorter leash, INCLUDING entering and exiting search areas in order to avoid dog to dog contact. Flexi leads are not permitted on trial grounds with the exception of inside the search area ONLY. Your dog may NOT leave the search area on a retractable leash of any kind.

RIBBONS, AWARDS, AND PRIZES

Placement ribbons will be awarded in each class as follows:

First Place	Blue
Second Place	Red
Third Place	Yellow
Fourth Place	White
Qualifying Score	Dark Green

A New Title rosette will be awarded to all dog and handler teams finishing a title.

Super Sniffer: Teams must qualify in all odor division elements, regardless of level split, in a single trial. Super Sniffer award is a scent work themed item such as a sticker or magnet as available and a flat ribbon. Sponsored by Hey Jude Creative.

Ribbons and prizes will not be mailed.

HIGH IN TRIAL (HIT)

HIT: Teams must enter and qualify in all standard titling elements offered within the same level. HIT is awarded to the team with the fewest faults and fastest cumulative time. HIT is awarded in each level. Novice A and B are scored together and only one HIT will be awarded for Novice.

High in Trial cannot be scored before all classes in a given level are completed.

Teams winning HIT will earn a Rosette from SWCBC and prize from Hey Jude Creative.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

SAFETY, BEHAVIOR AND LIABILITY

The safety of the dog is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all searches safely. **It is expressly understood** that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create an unnecessary disturbance or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the trial committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made. The Scent Work Club of Brevard County and its agents, employees, etc., will assume no responsibilities for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children. The Scent Work Club of Brevard County reserves the right to decline entries for cause and may remove any dog on account of aggression. No one shall have any recourse or claim against the Scent Work Club of Brevard County or any official thereof.

Collars, Leashes and Harnesses: **While not actively searching, dogs MUST be on a fixed length 6' or shorter leash, INCLUDING entering and exiting search areas in order to avoid dog to dog contact.** During searches, dogs must wear a properly fitted collar or harness approved by the judge. A wearable camera such as a Go Pro may be mounted to the dog's harness, if desired. Leashes may be of any length and/or retractable. The leash should be made of plain, pliable material.

All dogs must be on leash at all times, and retractable leashes may not be used when on trial grounds (except during judged searches). Dogs must enter and exit the search area with the leash attached to the collar or harness, including when waiting in the search area before and after

the search. An off-leash option may be offered at the discretion of the judge, only if the area is completely enclosed.

REFUNDS

No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. No entry fee will be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by the action of the Trial Committee. Dogs pulled after closing because of injury or other medical condition are not eligible for a refund.

Bitches in season will be refunded the full entry fee. Notification in writing must be given to the trial secretary no later than one half hour prior to the start of the first class of the day of the trial.

Refunds will be mailed by the club after the trial concludes. SWCBC does not make refunds under \$10 - check your entry fees!

Entries not admitted to the trial and withdrawn entries will be shredded, not be returned to the exhibitor.

Requests for returned checks and money orders must be made in writing to the Trial Secretary by email before the closing date and a self addressed and stamped envelope must be provided by the exhibitor.

RINGSIDE

Judges are not required to wait for dogs. The Owner of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at the search area when it is to be judged. The Club has no responsibility to provide service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.

EXHIBITOR CHECK-IN: Exhibitors must check in upon arrival each day and check in with the gate steward when classes are posted. Please know your armband number. Further information will be provided in the welcome letter

***Exhibitors MUST check-in EACH day they are entered.
Claims will be arbitrated as set forth on the Official AKC Entry Form for this event.***

"Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations." Additionally, clubs should include any specific local or state health requirements; for example, proof of rabies vaccination.

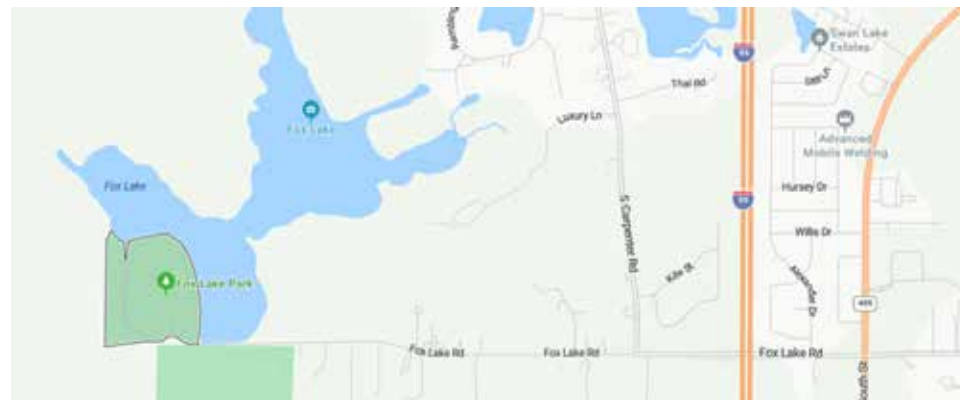
VOLUNTEERS

DIRECTIONS TO THE TRIAL SITE

Directions to venue: From the north or the south, take I95 to exit 215, SR50 (you'll be heading east) to Titusville; in about .3 miles turn north onto SR 405 (South Street); in 2.1 miles turn west onto Fox Lake Rd.; in 1.7 miles Fox Lake Park will be on the west side of the road. The Pavillion is at the back of the park.



Crating will be from your car; there are trees to park under and there may be limited crating space under the pavilion, all crates will need to be removed from the pavilion at the end of each day. There will be tents in waiting areas for the next team, if necessary. Buried and containers may be on concrete, tarps, carpeting, tile or grass

Should I enter Novice A or B?

Novice A is for beginner dogs, B is for dogs that have titled in that specific AKC Scent Work element OR a comparable event in another venue OR handlers who are professional K9 handlers OR Scent Work Judges. Obedience, Rally, Agility, etc. titles do not factor into B status.

If you title in Novice and would like to STAY in Novice for Elite legs, you MUST move to Novice B.

Example 1: You have your Container Novice title but have not yet titled in Interior Novice. To stay in Novice for Container, you would enter Novice B, but you can remain in A for Interior because you do not have your Interior Novice title yet.

Example 2: You have 2 dogs - Fido and FiFi. Fido is competing at the Excellent level in all elements. FiFi is just getting started and has never titled, FiFi can still be entered in Novice A, Fido would need to be in Novice B for elites.

Example 3: Your dog is just getting started in AKC but you have your NW1 - you must enter Novice B in Container, Interior, and Exterior (NACSW comparable events) but you may compete in Novice A for Buried and Handler Discrimination.

In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim of loss, injury or damage to this dog.
