## Tony's Thoughts

### The Beatitudes of Revelation

In the final chapter of Revelation, John is beholding great things about the eternal resting place for those who overcome this world. In John's visions, Rome has already been destroyed, the people of God have rejoiced over Rome's fall, and now he shows us things pertaining to their resting place. In this place there is the water of life coming from the throne of God, the tree of life, the Lord serving as their light, and other things.

What sticks out to me is the tree of life which was in the first paradise we read of (Gen. 2:9) along with this paradise. It sticks out to me because of the final blessed statement of Revelation. In 22:14, after hearing the Lord again proclaim His eternal nature and that He is coming in judgment (22:12-13), John writes, "Blessed are those who wash their robes, so that they may have the right to the tree of life, and may enter by the gates into the city." Having on white robes in Revelation signifies that you are God's chosen people, have overcome death, and are awaiting entering God's rest (6:11; 7:13-14). For them, John says that they have the right to the tree of life. All the way back in the Garden of Eden, the tree of life symbolized the life that God offers, whereas partaking of the tree of knowledge of good and evil symbolized death (Gen. 2:17). The implication is clear. For those who are faithful to death, they have the promise of eternal life.
