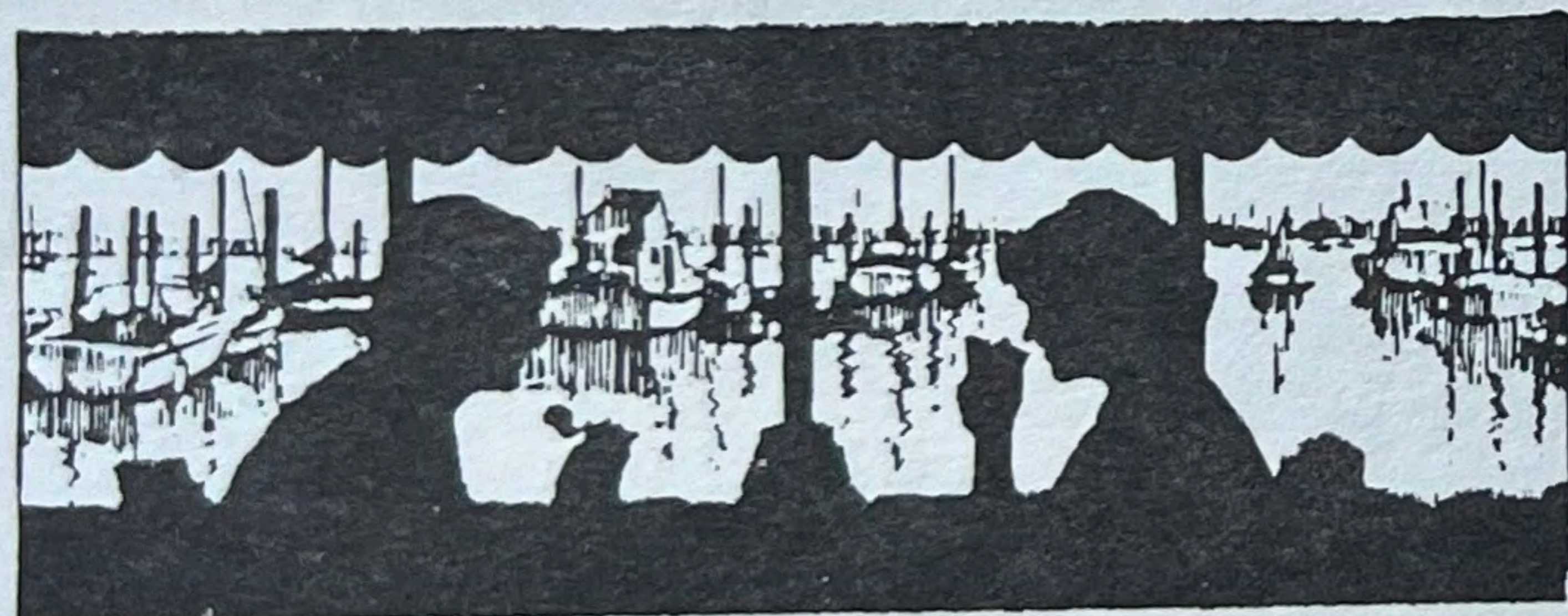

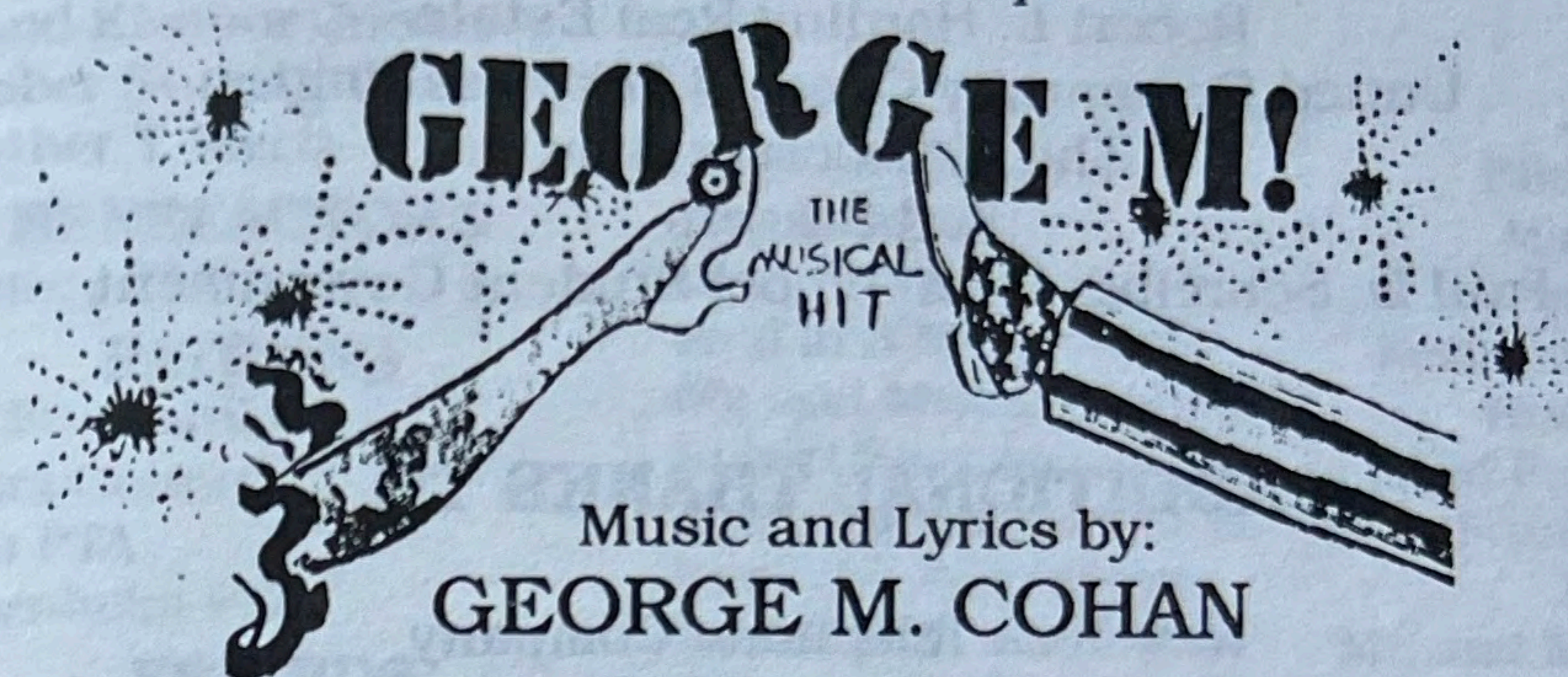

GEORGE M. COHAN

July, 1878 - November, 1942

"Never was a plant more indigenous to a particular part of the earth than was George M. Cohan to the United States of his day," Oscar Hammerstein wrote in the New York Times. Strutting, prancing, and talking a song out of the corner of his mouth, he was the personification of the debonair man of affairs with whom audiences were happy to identify themselves.

Beginning as a vaudeville act, the Four Cohans had become one of the nation's leading attractions by the turn of the century. Success, however, never stopped George M. Cohan from longing for the prestige of Broadway. Ever the entrepreneur, Cohan was able to strike a deal which brought his family and new wife Ethel to Broadway in February, 1901.

In partnership with Sam Harris, Cohan had his first Broadway success with *Little Johnny Jones* in 1904. This was soon to be followed by many more successes which gave the legacy of musical tunes for which he is well remembered.

George M. Cohan helped set a pattern for musicals that were to flourish in the twenties. Even today, we see his influence in the pace and atmosphere of *The Music Man*.

In 1958, history went full circle and theatregoers flocked to the high-powered musical based on his life, *George M!*.

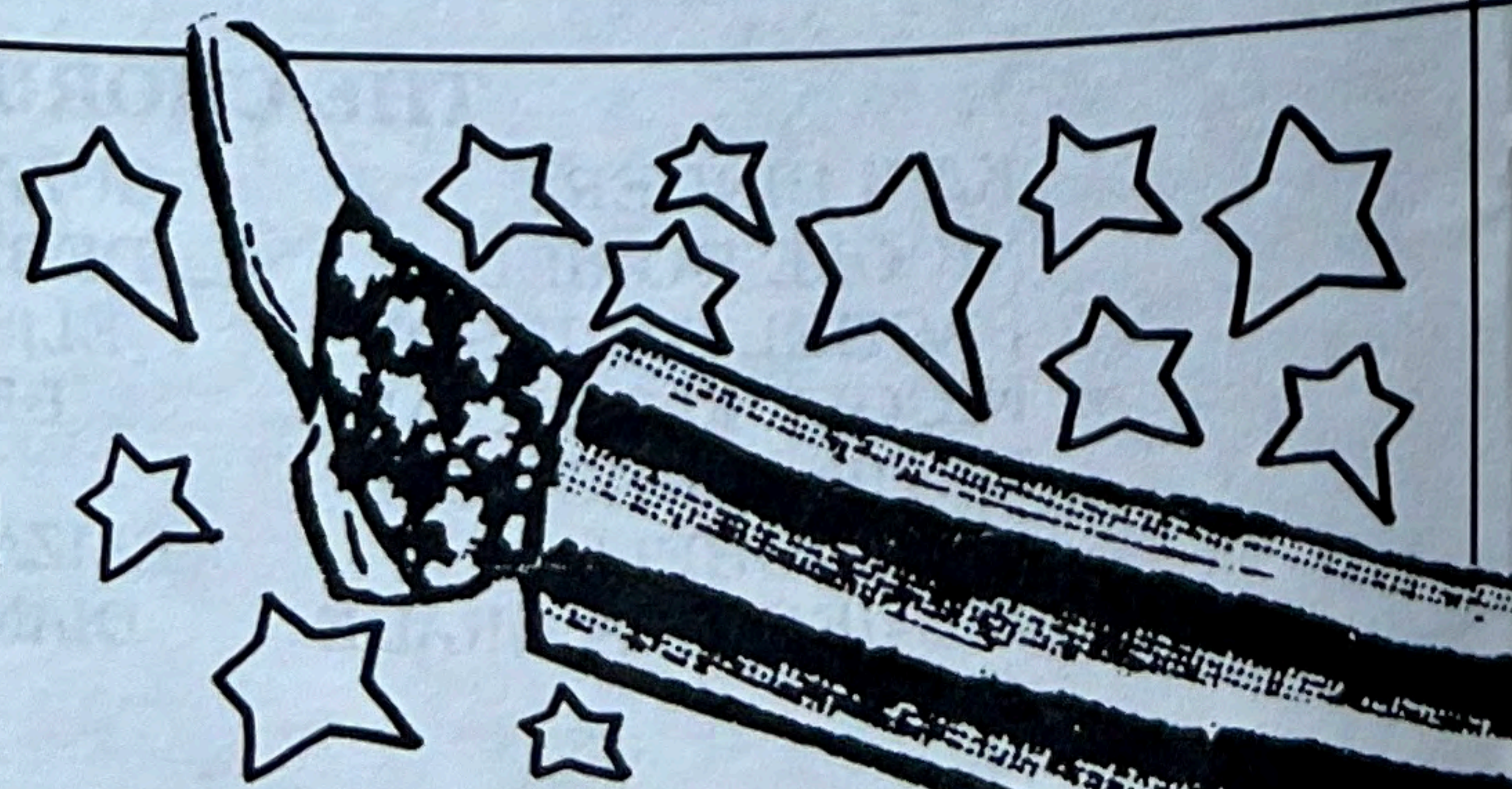

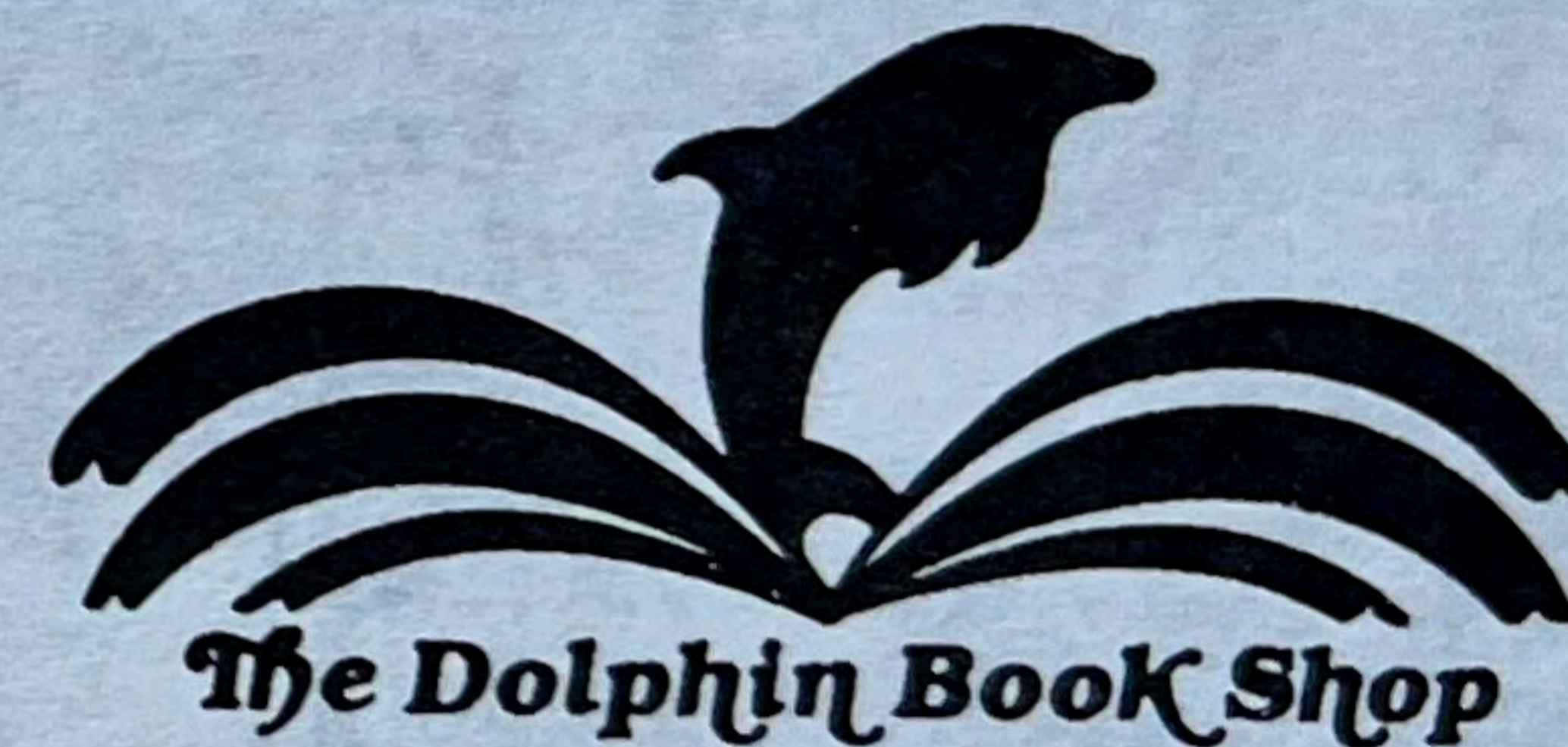

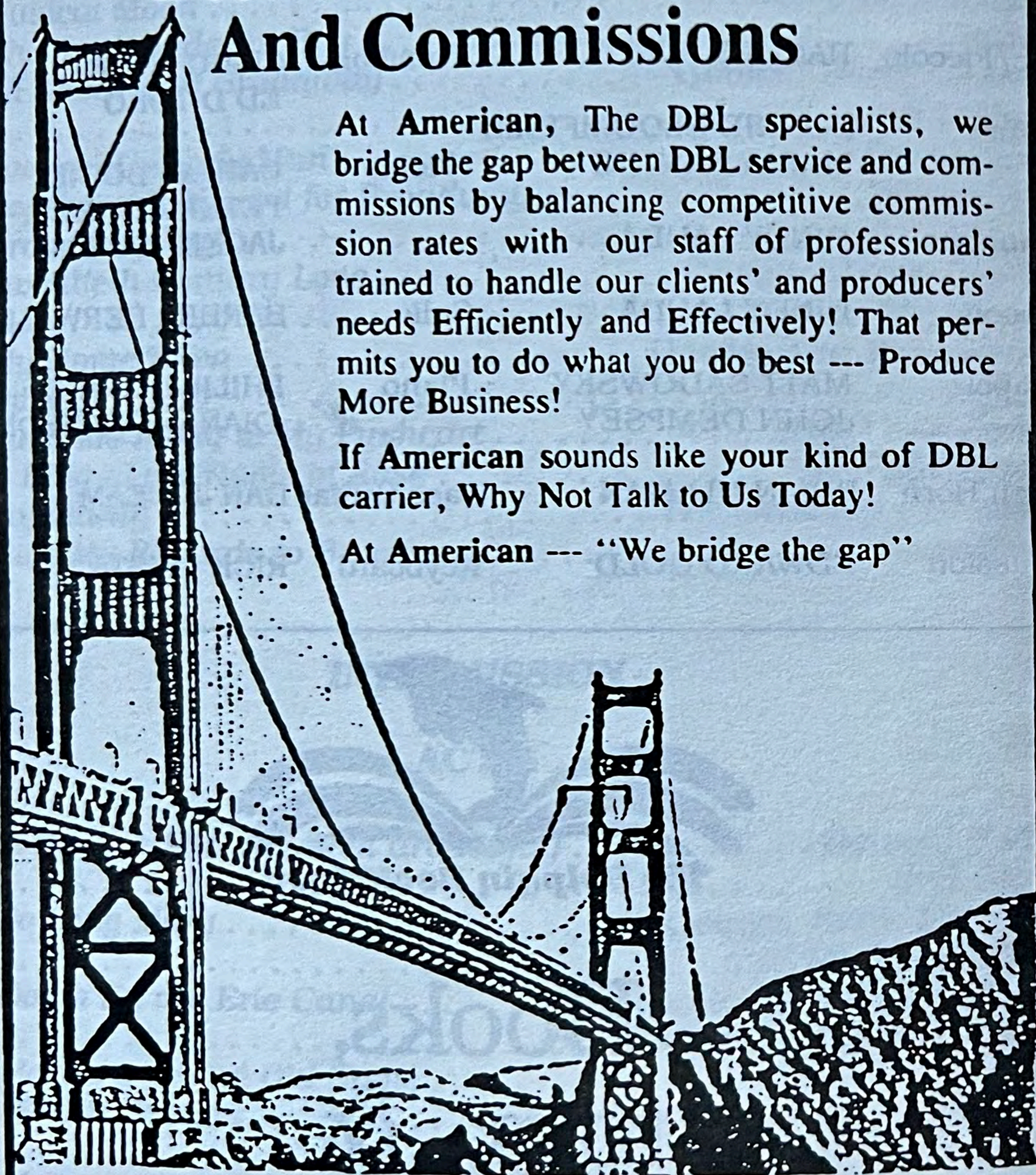

BEHIND THE SCENES

MARDI BRAUN (Co-Director) returns from last year's *Bye Bye Birdie*. Best known locally for her role as Laurie in *Oklahoma!*, Gooch in *Mame*, and Peep Bo in the Port Singer's recent production of *The Mikado*. Mardi made her professional debut touring with "Brotherhood" while she was a student at Adelphi. She has also performed with the Village Light Opera of Manhattan, and is currently a partner with Cam Gelb in Merlin Productions.

CAM GELB (Co-Director) makes a return engagement after last year's successful *Bye Bye Birdie*. A 7-year resident of Port Washington, Cam made her Broadway debut in *Babes In Toyland*. She also appeared in numerous stock productions including *Carousel*, with John Raitt; *Fiddler on the Roof*; *Mame*; and *Bye Bye Birdie*. She toured Europe in *The Apple Tree* for the USO-American Theatre Wing. Here in Port Washington she has appeared as Sharon in *Finian's Rainbow*; Golux in *The Thirteen Clocks*; and as Pitti Sing in the Port Singer's *Mikado*.

PHILIP GLOVER (Musical Director), the choral director at Schreiber, has also been the musical director for numerous shows in Port Washington: with the Port Singer's, *Mame* and *Finian's Rainbow*; at Weber Junior High School, *Pippin* and *Guys and Dolls*; and at Schreiber, *The Apple Tree*; *Little Mary Sunshine*; and *Little Shop of*

Horrors. He was also the musical director for the past summer show productions of *How to Succeed in Business Without Really Trying*, and Cole Porter's *Red, Hot, and Blue*. His wife and 15-month-old daughter have supported his efforts by sharing him with us night after night.

ANN KOPPLE (Art Director), while teaching for six years in the Virgin Islands, designed many carnival floats for her school. She also traveled throughout the schools on St. Thomas as an itinerant muralist, painting scenes of Caribbean culture. These exploits led to a book which she wrote and illustrated on folklore of the Virgin Islands. She is interested in writing another book on children's art in the near future. Miss Kopple has previously designed sets for many Gilbert and Sullivan productions including *The Mikado*; *H.M.S. Pinafore*; *Trial By Jury*; *Pirates of Penzance*; and *The Gondoliers*. She has also worked on the sets of such shows as *Godspell*; *Little Shop of Horrors*; *Music Man*; *Bye, Bye Birdie*; *Once Upon A Mattress*; and *Oliver!* Her interests outside of school include windsurfing, writing, rock climbing, painting, and beach combing.

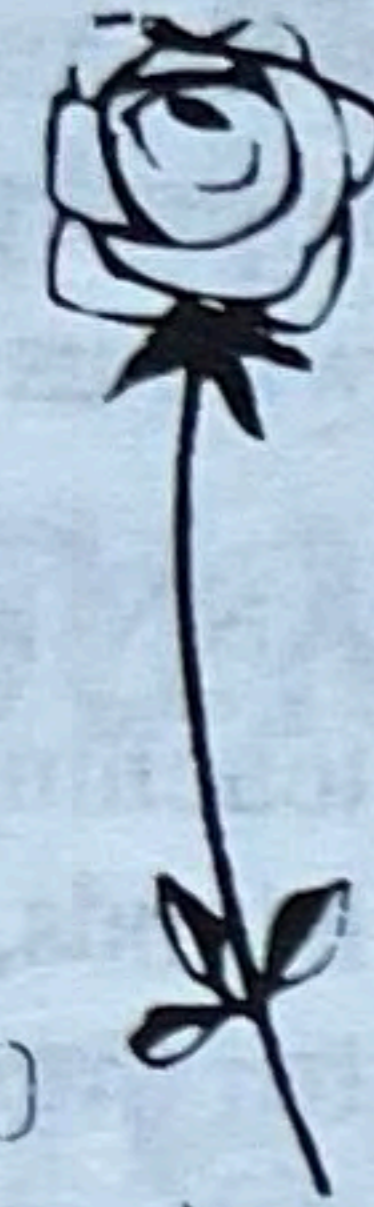

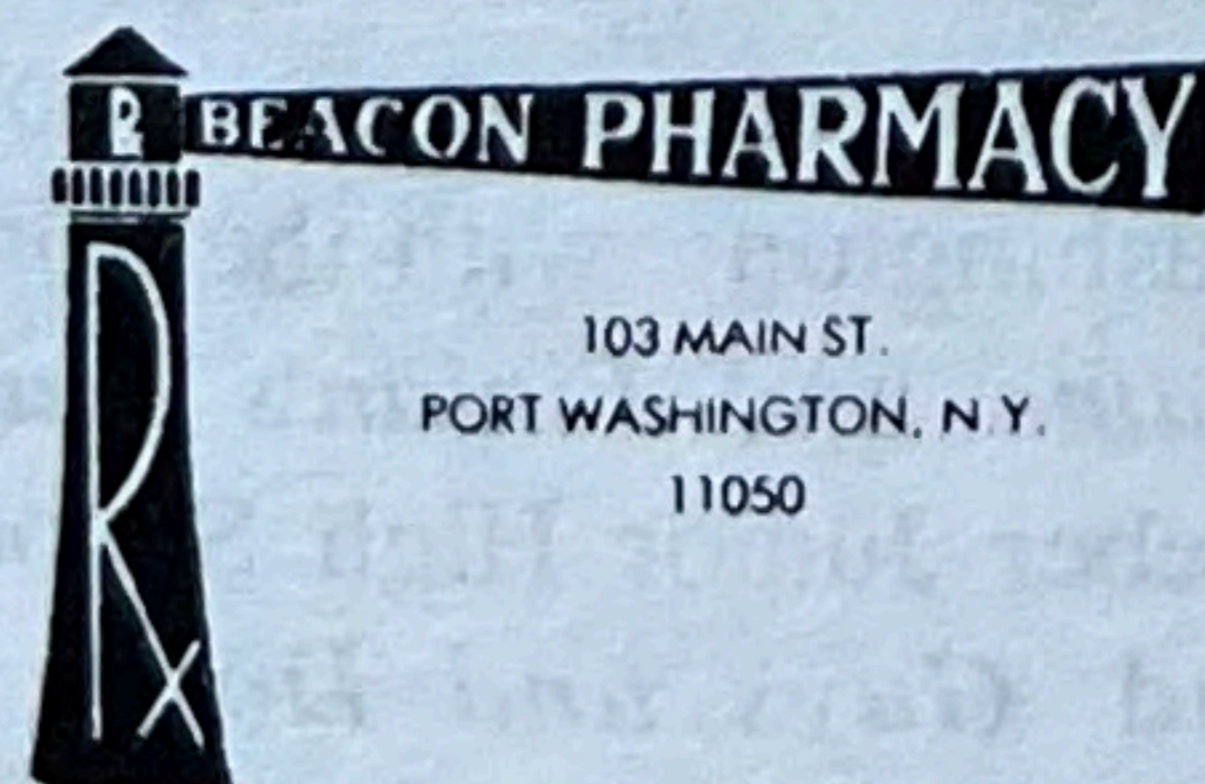

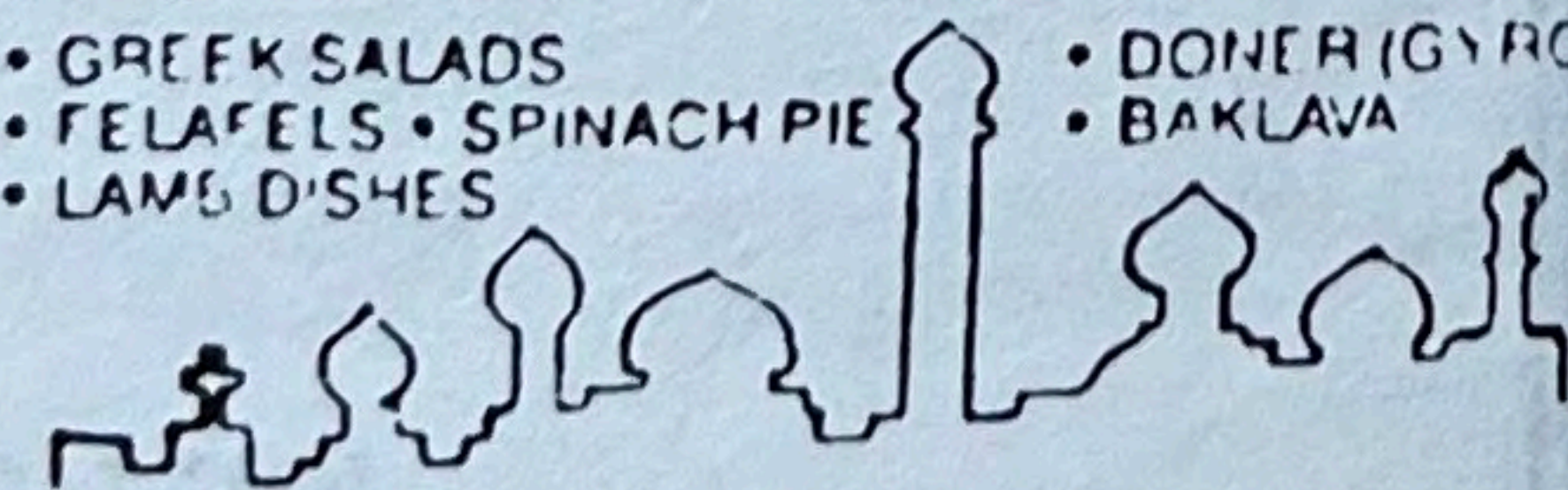
