

### ABOUT THIS PRODUCTION

### How an 'Unproduceable' Show Became 'Must-See'

According to conventional logic, *Urinetown* is a show that was never supposed to succeed. When you look at this show's track record, though, it becomes clear that its immense success lies in the satirizing, thwarting and challenging of those conventions, in defiance of the supposed logic.

In 1995, Greg Kotis went on a two-week soul-searching trip to Paris that would soon go awry. Within days, he was counting his coins and rearranging his budget to accommodate his unexpected spending, especially on restroom use. Without Google to help him, he had little way of knowing that all Parisian public toilets were pay-per-use.

He counted himself lucky that he had the option to hold on until the next meal to relieve himself — but what if he were unlucky? What if the only option were pay-per-use toilets run by a corrupt, monopolizing corporation under public contract?

It sounded like an unsellable show concept, but that didn't dissuade his friend and writing partner, Mark Hollmann, who would soon write "It's A Privilege to Pee." Four years later, Kotis and Hollmann had their "unproduceable" show produced at the New York City Fringe Festival, to be closely followed by a brief Off-Broadway stint and a critically acclaimed 965-performance Broadway run.

In fact, it was one of only a few Broadway shows to open that year – immediately after 9/11 — and survive past that season, in spite of its political undertones.

So how was *Urinetown* able to do the impossible? The answer can be found in its unflinching humor.

The music is built from the bones of past shows, carved and shaped into clever parodies

and references both celebratory and irreverent. The characters are modeled on archetypes as old as Western theatre itself, from the ingénue to the fallen worldly-wise woman to the everyman male protagonist. But the archetypes are flipped on their heads as their worlds turn upside down. Our pair of narrators consistently address the theatricality of their situation, while also carrying their own conflicting storytelling biases.

This show helped Broadway laugh at itself again, at a time in our nation's history when laughter was hard to come by.

It's easier to accept and enjoy an unapologetic political satire like *Urinetown* now, 13 years after it opened on the Great White Way, because it helped blaze a new trail for political satire in a post-postmodern world.

It's also easier to understand why this musical is so important. Fracking, climate change, California's severe drought and former Nestlé C.E.O. Peter Brabeck's 2005 statement calling for the privatization of all water supplies have captured the attention of the nation recently, as bits and pieces of the dystopia that this show reveals fall into place, faster than Kotis and Hollmann could have anticipated.

That's why this show is so important. It offers a critical eye to the world of water management and corrupt politics, and it addresses our fears in a way where laughter can bring new insight to real-world problems. It takes otherwise-unpalatable information and serves it in a dish so delicious, you won't want to put your fork down until your plate is clean.

Most importantly, it tells a story that needs to be told, and changes the way audiences 'tink' about our world.

### ABOUT THIS PRODUCTION

"You said to follow your heart / Here's where my heart leads:"

#### My Long Journey Through Urinetown

My love affair with *Urinetown: The Musical* began when I was a senior in college. Those of us theater nerds who pay attention to such things had heard of this scrappy little show that could, moving from the Fringe Festival all the way up to a major Broadway venue. I had no idea what to expect when I entered the theater the night I went to see it. And I could never have anticipated finding a show that so strongly spoke to my tastes — in humor, in style, in wit and in effectiveness. I was hooked.

It was not until 2005 that I finally got a chance to direct the show for the first time. Doing the show with a college drama group was a special kind of joy. Their willingness to be over the top, to take chances, and to mine the show for all its wonderful humor was truly a gift to me.

That production was one of the most successful shows on which I have ever had the pleasure of working. Though I am often proud of the work I do on stage, this was a new kind of excitement. Once more, I was hooked.

Seven productions later, I am still hooked. No two versions of the show that I have done have ever been the same. Part of the reason I am still hooked is that there is always something new to find in this material — new humor, new approaches to staging and characterization — and every cast puts its own indelible stamp on the show.

And now the Port Summer Show is my new playground for this delightfully wacky show that is like no other.

The excitement I have in sharing this show with this very talented group of young perform-

ers cannot be fully described. Watching as the humor clicks for them and they start to get creative is an amazing thing to witness. They have gone above and beyond in their commitment to this show, and I truly believe this passion is evident in the finished product.

What cannot be ignored is the message at the core of this show: Follow your heart. I am sadly astounded on a daily basis by how much negativity there is in the world —not only on the grand political and socioeconomic stages, but on the very mundane day-to-day level as well. We spend so much time looking for what's wrong around us that we forget to see all that's right.

"Follow your heart" at first appears to be such a cliché that it is easy to dismiss. But following your heart is hard, especially when it means you have to face down negativity and those who are trying to hurt you.

But I have found there is no other way to win over such obstacles than with great heart, love and generosity of spirit. It is a message I hope all of these performers remember and keep with them even after this show is a faded memory.

I hope I keep getting to visit *Urinetown* throughout the rest of my career. It is a place I really enjoy visiting. It reminds me to smile at the ridiculousness of the world. It encourages me to fight against negativity with smiles, laughter, and kindness.

It tells me to follow my heart — and really, what better advice is there than that?

### John Fasano

Last month, the Summer Show community lost one of its most accomplished and beloved alumni.

John Fasano (On The Town in 1977 through Kismet in 1982) made a big impression on the Play Troupe and the Summer Show, as he did everywhere he went. Whether making an entrance carrying an entire squad of dancing girls onstage in Kismet or being one of the notorious pranksters who got Play Troupe banned from the Memorial Day Parade (for playing catch with Macbeth's head in front of the reviewing stand), John was never one to get lost in the crowd.

He was a unique mixture of Lou Ferrigno and Stubby Kaye, able to dance lightly across the stage and then break a two-by-four over his neck. Whichever side of John you saw, song-and-dance man or Incredible Hulk, nobody who ever met him could forget the man who embodied both halves of that unlikely pair.

John went on to a long, successful career in Hollywood, specializing in action films



(Another 48 Hours, Tombstone, Alien 5), and now-classic horror films (Rock 'n' Roll Nightmare, Black Roses). He paved the Hollywood path for many Summer Show alumni who now live and work there. His heart was always in Port Washington, and he married a Schreiber sweetheart and fellow Summer Show alum, Edie King.

Like the kids you will see tonight, John spent his summers building sets and rehearsing lines for the Summer Show, and it became part of him.

He was a grand collaborator, a skilled artist and a versatile talent, and a beloved friend to all.




