JIM JACOBS (Book, Music and Lyrics). Jacobs, who created Grease (in 1970) with Warren Casev, was born and raised on the mean streets of Chicago's far northwest side. During the golden era of rock 'n' roll (1956-1960) he was a guitar-playing "greaser" student at Taft High School. In 1963, Jacobs met Warren Casey when they were both cast in a local theatre production of A Shot in the Dark. Seven years later they wrote what was to become one of the greatest musicals of all time. Grease opened in 1971 in a former trolley barn called the Kingston Mines Theatre in Chicago. A year later, Grease made it to Broadway and "Greasemania" took off, resulting in one of the longest running shows in Broadway history. The 1978 movie became and remains the highest grossing movie musical of all time. Originally an actor, Jacobs has been seen on television, in motion pictures, regional theatre, national tours, and on Broadway. He is the co-author of several other plays and musicals including Island of Lost Coeds, a musical spoof of the low budget sci-fi/horror/ jungle movies of the 1950s, which he wrote with Warren Casey. In May 2014, Mr. Jacobs was presented with an honorary doctorate degree from Columbia College in Chicago. He currently resides in Southern California and remains active in the theatre, especially with the American Theatre Company of Chicago.

WARREN CASEY (Author, Composer and Lyricist) was born in Yonkers, New York, and attended Syracuse University. During the late '50s, he learned all about "greasers" while working as an art teacher in upstate New York. He moved to Chicago in 1962, where he hoped to pursue an acting career. He appeared in dozens of productions, including creating the role of Bernie Litko in David Mamet's Sexual Perversity in Chicago. He supported himself with iobs in retail, including working as an assistant manager of a chain of apparel stores, and as a record salesman. In the meantime, he taught himself how to play the guitar and began writing songs. Mr. Casey acted with the Chicago Stage Guild (where he met Jim Jacobs), the Old Town Players, and the Kingston Mines Theatre. The latter company staged the original production of GREASE which he wrote with Jim Jacobs. After the incredible success of both the musical and the movie, the two collaborated on Island of Lost Coeds, a musical satire of the B-movies of the 1950s. Mr. Casey died in 1988.

Summer Theater In Port



The following is a portion of the article which was originally printed in "Portfolio of Homes, June 1988". Now celebrating our 45th Anniversary, we are proud to still be bringing the excitement of musical theater to Port Washington teens!

There was once a girl in Port Washington (her name was Kathe O'Connor) who, not being from a nautical tennisplaying family, said "There is nothing creative to do in Port in the summer!"

Fortunately, she said it to the young woman who had been directing the winter children's show for Play Troupe, Port's regular theater group.

The woman was Pam Meadows and she relayed this cry of teen-age ennui to her husband who was on the board of the Bandshell Committee which sponsored Port's summer band shows. Between them, they persuaded Play Troupe, and the Bandshell, to sponsor Port's first Teen Theater production.

So from that cry was born a tradition - summer theater in Port Washington.

The first show, in 1972, was "Anything Goes".

"We had no money so we improvised everything. We used cyclone fences with muslin drops for the scenery - for every scene change, we just flipped over the next sheet of muslin," said Ron Meadows who produced the shows and designed the sets.

"The Bandshell is right by the water and 'Anything Goes' is a nautical show, so the sea in the background supplied plenty of atmosphere." added Pam.

Ron created a tower from plumbers' piping and Brook Electric put in a power outlet. Ron had six lights to aim at the stage.

The next year was "Bye Bye

Birdie" - and eight lights! One night there were 1,000 people crowded onto the green to see the show and the Meadows realized they needed better stage facilities.

By the fourth year, the Adult Education Department of the Port school system invited them to perform in the Schreiber High School Auditorium.

Then, in keeping with the ups and downs of show business, Austerity struck. The school board's budget failed to pass which meant all the "frills" were cut out and the show could only go on if it paid its own way.

"It's not that we lacked sponsors," said Ron Meadows, "it's just that we wanted sponsors who would let us do things our way."

Teen Theater policy was always that the kids do as much as possible themselves - make and paint the scenery, make their own costumes or find them in local thrift shops (though some parents, mothers mostly, have been known to wield a dab needle), and help with production, publicity, and ticket sales.

Although the summer theater has always been low budget, production fees have to be paid for, as well as script rentals, and in the throes of austerity, custodial fees had to be paid when the Schreiber auditorium was used.

Eventually, some parents found benefactors for the show - I.B.M. (who owns a golf club in Port) and the Robert L. Harding Real Estate firm. Since 1980 Robert Harding has been a regular benefactor.

In spite of the constant struggle for sufficient funds, the Teen Theater went from strength to strength.

Kids can take part the summer they finish sixth grade and if they catch the "theater bug" they can do it every summer until they finish High School. Plenty of kids have been through seven Teen Theater productions, starting in the chorus and working their way into bigger and better parts as they got older.

For the fifteenth summer, the Meadows put on a full-fledged "Peter Pan" with an instructor from Foy Inventor-prises sprinkling a little fairy dust, so to speak, to help Peter and the Darling children fly to Never-Never Land.

The show was the last in the galaxy of "smash hits" which included "Guys and Dolls", "Oliver", "Grease", and "Annie". It was the fifteenth show, and Pam and Ron both said "Enough".

The threat of no more Teen Theater caused a minor panic among that segment of Port's population for whom it had become a way of life.

Everyone possible was recruited - the Port Washington Youth Council, the School Board in the guise of Adult Education, Bob Harding, of course, and I.B.M. again. But who was going to direct, who to produce?

Directing talent was hired from outside Port which proved that even with the best intentions, it's tough to do this particular job if you commute from the city each day.

Since the Teen Theater had been the Meadows' "baby", it was decided to change the name slightly. The Port Summer Show went on, with "Barnum"...

We embrace our 2017 production of "All Shook Up" with the same love, care and passion that started the Port Summer Show in 1972. To Kathe O'Connor, the teenager who sparked it all, we applaud you wherever you are and say, "Break A Leg"!



A NOTE FROM OUR DIRECTOR

"I got chills - they're multiplyin'": Grease Is Always The Word

There is probably some crazy statistic out there that tells us that the musical Grease is performed in some theater somewhere every weekend throughout the year. It is a show that has become a rite of passage for many - you aren't truly a member of the musical theatre world if you haven't been in or seen a production of Grease. I was 17 when I did my very first production of Grease, playing the guitar-strumming geek Doody. And this Port Summer Show production is probably my tenth or twelfth...or twentieth. You really do begin to lose count after five or six. But it still has a power over me, and every time I hear the music, I still get those chills Danny Zuko sings about at the end of the film.

Trust me, you're going to get those chills. This is an extraordinary cast. They have taken every step of choreography created by the masterful Jesse Pellegrino and brought it to thrilling, energetic life. They have taken characters that have been a part of the cultural landscape for so long and truly made them their own. You won't find carbon copies of the movie performances here - they have created the characters in their own unique vision. So, if you have seen the show before or if you are a die-hard fan of the movie, you're in a for a terrific surprise.

But there is another type of chill that Grease now creates for some of us and to ignore it would be a slap in the face to the progress we have made culturally and socially in the many years since Grease first became popular. There is no denying that in our more educated, modern world, the message that could be the take-away from this show is troubling. Changing who you are to please someone else? Not cool. It never really was, but it definitely isn't now. However, I would like to offer a different message to all the young (and young-at heart) folks watching our show. Pay close attention to Sandy in the drive-in movie scene. Hear her words and watch how she stands up for herself. Sandy is the embodiment of strength in that scene, and her subsequent "transformation" at the end of the show isn't really about transforming; it's about taking ownership of who you are. It's Sandy saying, "I can be whatever and whoever I want to be because I KNOW who I am and NO ONE will ever take advantage of me." I get different chills watching that drive-in scene than I used to years ago. I hope we do justice to this new messaging we hope to put forth in the show.

I am honored to work with such a dedicated, generous, and genuine group of people each year in Port Washington. They give me chills, too. And yes, they're also electrifyin'! Enjoy the show!
