Golf Committee

The golf video is delayed due to weather. They plan to shoot segments with Brady, Andrew and Frank talking about club selection and club fitting. Michelle will be able to help with the video production. It should be sent out in the next few weeks.

They still are working on the issue of twosomes taking up tee times. Andrew had golf video queued up to be sent out in coming weeks.

Racquet and Fitness Committee

Kathy Griffin-Mayo provided an update on racquet sports and fitness.

Memorial Day traffic was pretty good, the weather on Friday/Saturday obviously wasn't ideal so they didn't have as many people around as last year. Full clinic schedule started this week, so they are happy to get everything in motion for the summer. The rain and cold temperatures haven't really helped but they've been able to play through most of it. Attendance as expected this week has been erratic but it feels like a transition week for most families. Most of the tennis clinic programming has stayed the same, our numbers last year were very strong so no major changes.

Pickleball clinic attendance took a big dip last year, so the pickleball clinic programming has been revamped and most of it is completely new this year. They have a clear pathway set up for someone getting started in Pickle to go from the 101 Clinic where they learn rules, scoring, etc., to the 102 clinic where they can start to learn basic strategy and technique. From there they should be able to play in Social Open Play, and move on to the Skills and Drills Clinic where they work more on technique and match implementation. And from there they should be ready to compete in the DUPR Open Play sessions and attend our more advanced Doubles Strategy Clinic which involves more live ball practice.

They have our Dink for Diabetes Pickleball Tournament this Saturday afternoon. They have 54 members signed up for it. Proceeds from the tournament go to the Breakthrough Type 1 Diabetes Foundation, Natalie said that they have already raised more money this year than they did at last year's event.

They purchased a new tool to help dry our Hard Courts after rain, it's called a VAPTR Court Roller. It removes 95% of water from the court surface on a single pass. They are very impressed and never seen anything this effective at drying a court. In the past it would have taken us about 2 hours with 4 employees (and hopefully some sun and/or wind) to dry out the 8 pickleball courts. They can now get all 8 playable in less than an hour with only 2 employees.

Jen said they added more classes to the schedule in June with the next new classes beginning next week. Pool classes start next week. Beach yoga is back! Kelly will be teaching Saturday mornings. Sue will be every other Tuesday on the beach. Last year we had 39 classes on the schedule heading into 4th July weekend. This year they

have 47 scheduled. 11am classes were added Monday, Wednesday and Friday and so far received well. More Sunday classes.

Waterfront Committee
