Prepare treatment rooms for patient by following prescribed procedures and protocols.

Prepare patients for physical therapy treatment by welcoming, comforting, providing and/or assisting patient into physical therapy apparel or apertures.

Assist the treating physical therapist with modalities, helping patients onto exercise equipment, monitoring motion, tracking walking time and distance, measuring mobility, and performing prescribed exercises and strengthening techniques.

Maintain patient confidence and protects operations by keeping information confidential.

Maintain a safe and clean working environment by complying with procedures, rules, and regulations.

Provide equipment and supplies by sterilizing and delivering equipment and supplies to treatment area, positioning equipment for therapist access, and positioning patient on equipment.
