Thank you for your letter/notice dated May 15, 2017 of which copy is enclosed along with this response.

In your latter so said:

We applied \$2183.07 of your OVERPAYMENT to an unpaid balance. As a result, your REFUND has been reduced to \$0.00.

And you proceeded to explain that the **alleged unpaid balance** was for a civil penalty owed for December 31, 2013.

I also demand any and all due process to which I am entitled to or which is in any way appropriate and/or available to me under any provision or practice of common, statutory, and/or administrative law or protocol including, but not limited to, that to which your letter/notice CP12 refers to. Be advised that it is my intent as expressed before to audio record any and all proceedings for which such option is lawfully available to me, and to also file civil suit for refund of all unlawfully and maliciously retained funds since 2013 and that this letter should also serve as my notice to you of that intent.

I declare that I make no admissions as to my status, the legitimacy of your implicit or explicit assertions, or the fines (or unpaid amounts,) or the fitness of any particular legal or administrative protocol by responding to your letter/ notice CP12 or by requesting or demanding the due process referenced above.
