The course emphasizes that safety is a critical element of effective site supervision.

Endorsed by the UK Contractors Group, the SSSTS is recognized as the industry standard for supervisors working on UKCG sites.

- Certificates are valid for five years; it is recommended to take a refresher course every three years to stay current with industry changes
