Over the course of 6 hours, participants will learn to identify signs of mental health conditions and offer practical advice and support, while understanding their limits as non-medical professionals.

Who Should Attend?



SITE SUPERVISORS' SAFETY TRAINING SCHEME (SSSTS)



Site Supervisors' Safety Training Scheme

The Site Supervisors' Safety Training Scheme (SSSTS) is a CITB-accredited course designed for those who have or are about to assume supervisory responsibilities in the construction industry. This two-day training is essential for supervisors to gain a solid understanding of health, safety, welfare, and environmental issues, and the legal duties that impact their role. The course emphasises that safety is a critical element of effective site supervision.

Endorsed by the UK Contractors Group, the SSSTS is recognised as the industry standard for supervisors working on UKCG sites.

Who Should Attend?

This course is perfect for current or aspiring site supervisors in the construction industry, as well as anyone looking to move into a supervisory role. Whether you're already overseeing workers on-site or preparing to step into that role, this course equips you with the necessary skills to ensure site safety and compliance with legal standards.

Key Course Features

- Duration: 2 days
- · Location: Classroom-based training
- Group Size: Limited to ensure personalised attention and interactive learning

- Certificates are valid for five years; it is recommended to take a refresher course every three years to stay current with industry changes

As soon as you have received your Claim Authorisation Note (CAN) you must forward this to us at your earliest convenience and pay the personal contribution specified on the CAN. Under the terms of the ELC scheme we can only confirm your place once you have presented your CAN and paid your contribution. 5. Transferring your Course Booking

Should circumstances mean that you need to transfer to another course the following charges will apply, dependent on the notice given:

- First transfer made more than 28 days prior to the course start date – no charge
- Additional transfers or first transfer made with 27 to 15 days' notice given - 25% of the course fee.
- Any transfer with 14 days or less notice – 50% of the course fee

6. Cancellations
