WHY IT MATTERS

Here's a step-by-step guide to help you align PDR feedback with impactful SHEQ training requirements.

1 Analyse PDR Data for SHEQ-Relevant Insights

The first step is to review PDR outcomes with an eye on SHEQ competencies.

Look for:

Skill Gaps: Are there areas where employees lack critical knowledge or skills in health and safety, environmental practices, or quality management?

Behavioural Patterns: Do trends indicate a need for enhanced awareness, such as safety culture or leadership in quality initiatives?

2 Map Identified Needs to SHEQ Training

Once insights are clear, link them to specific SHEQ training modules:

Compliance Training: For gaps in understanding regulations like ISO 45001, ISO 9001, or environmental standards.

Risk Awareness & Management: Address issues related to hazard identification, reporting, or mitigation.

Soft Skills in SHEQ: Enhance leadership, communication, and decision-making for a proactive safety and quality culture.

3 Analyse PDR Data for SHEQ-Relevant Insights

Not all gaps are equal. Use a risk-based approach to prioritise SHEQ training:

High Risk: Critical SHEQ gaps affecting compliance or safety should be addressed immediately.

Medium Risk: Areas impacting productivity or morale should follow. Low Risk: Long-term development initiatives can be scheduled later.

4 Map Identified Needs to SHEQ Training

One size doesn't fit all. Ensure training is customised to job-specific needs and learning styles:

- Operational Staff: Focus on practical, hands-on SHEQ practices.
- **Managers:** Include strategic and leadership training in SHEQ integration.
- **New Hires:** Build foundational SHEQ knowledge with onboarding programmes.

5 Monitor and Evaluate Post-Training Performance

Training doesn't end in the classroom. Track the effectiveness of SHEQ training:

- **Feedback Mechanisms:** Gather input from employees on training relevance and applicability.
- **Performance Metrics:** Measure outcomes like reduced incidents, improved compliance, or enhanced audit scores.
- **Follow-Up Reviews:** Revisit SHEQ progress in the next PDR cycle.

6 Integrate Training with Continuous Improvement

Use SHEQ training as part of a larger improvement cycle:

- Policy Updates: Adjust policies based on PDR and training outcomes.
- Accreditation Support: Leverage training to strengthen certifications like ISO, OHSAS or accreditations like Achilles and UVDB
- **Culture Building:** Create a workplace where SHEQ principles are lived daily.
