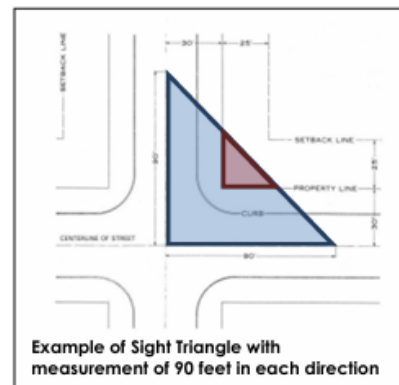

Bennet Zoning Ordinance states that vegetation should not be allowed to grow in such a manner to impede vision at intersections. This includes obstruction of any type of traffic sign at an intersection. For everyone's safety please keep your intersection corners clear of vegetation and debris.

Excerpt from the Sight Triangle Zoning Ordinance:

Nothing shall be erected, placed, planted, or allowed to grow in such a manner as to materially impede vision between a height of two and one-half feet and 10 feet above the grades of the bottom of the curb of the intersecting streets, measured from the point of intersection of the centerline of the streets along the centerline of the streets.
