Utility Bills & Collection:

It seems like there are more and more late fee/disconnect notices being sent each month and to hopefully help everyone understand the way the billing works, here are some excerpts from the Municipal Code for Bennet.

50.02 (C) Utility bills shall be mailed on or about the first day of each month and shall be due and payable by the fifteenth day of each month. Bills not paid by the fifteenth day of each month shall be deemed to be delinquent and a monthly late fee equal to 10% of the amount due shall be charged against each such delinquent account.

50.03 (A) The municipality shall have the right to discontinue utility services and remove its properties if the charges for the services are not paid within seven days after the date the charges become delinquent. Service shall not be discontinued for at least seven days, weekends and holidays excluded, after notice is sent or given.
