REMINDER

There have been multiple reports about young children (under 16) driving ATV's, UTV's and golf car vehicles around Bennet.

The Bennet Municipal Code requires all drivers of golf car vehicles, ATV's and UTV's to have a valid drivers license, proof of insurance and the machine equipped with a bicycle safety flag.

Golf car vehicles are not allowed to drive on Hwy 43, only to cross the road directly in front of you.

Municipal Code § 91.19 DEAD OR DISEASED TREES:

It is hereby declared a nuisance for a property owner to permit, allow, or maintain any dead or diseased trees on private property or within the right-of-way of streets within the corporate limits of the city or within its extraterritorial zoning jurisdiction.

§ 93.18 OVERHANGING BRANCHES

(A) The owner or occupant of any lot, piece, or parcel of ground abutting or adjacent to any street or sidewalk over which there extends the branches of trees shall at all times keep the branches or limbs thereof trimmed to the height of at least eight feet above the surface of the walk and at least 14 feet above the surface of the street.
