TextMyGov



TextMyGov has been an informational tool for the City of Bennet since October 2024 but promotional efforts at that time did not result in a lot of enrollments. With the recent water emergency and once again promoting this tool, we have had over two hundred enrollments at this time. This is very encouraging for the city staff since we can send out messages related to day-to-day activities, and also any emergency situations such as the recent water restrictions. Be sure to share the enrollment information with any of your neighbors and friends who need to receive alerts from the City of Bennet.

The City of Bennet has purchased a used sewer jetting machine that can be used by staff to regularly jet (clean out) sewer lines throughout the city. The purpose is to try and alleviate as many sewer backups and blockages as possible and to provide regular maintenance of the city's sewer lines.

When jetting is happening in your area, you may experience sewer gas smell that will come up through any floor drains that are not full of water. This usually happens in the older homes that have a floor drain that is not properly vented. An alert will be sent out when the jetting is occurring and if you live in the area affected, you can be better prepared by pouring water in the floor drain.

REMINDER

There have been multiple reports about young children (under 16) driving ATV's, UTV's and golf carts around Bennet.

The Bennet Municipal Code requires all drivers of golf carts, ATV's and UTV's to have a valid drivers license, proof of insurance and the machine equipped with a bicycle safety flag.

This is a safety issue and no one wants to see any child hurt in an accident that could be prevented!
