UTILITY BILLS

The City Office has received several phone calls and emails concerning the Utility Billing System and Dates. According to the Municipal Code of Bennet, §50.02, the water meters are to be read during the last week of the month. Utility bills are to be mailed on or about the first (1) day of the month and are due and payable by the fifteenth (15) of each month. Bills not paid by the 15th of the month are delinquent and are charged a late fee equal to 10% of the amount due. The City of Bennet provides several options for customers to be able to pay their utility bill by the 15th. In person during office hours, online at www.cityofbennet.com, drop box outside City Hall, calling the city office and paying with a credit card over the phone or automatically withheld from a customer's bank account on the 15th of the month.

The disconnection notice is mailed on or about the 16th of the month and shut off's are scheduled for seven working days after the 16th.

The billing invoices and disconnect notices are delivered direct to the Post Office and given to the postal worker with the intention of getting them processed quicker. Any complaints about dates received by residents of Bennet need to be address to the Post Office.

Resolution No. 2022-4.2 changed the utility reconnection fee for discontinued service to \$100.00.
