With all of the rain we have received, just wanted to remind all residents of the current Municipal Code:

§ 91.20

The owner or occupant of any lot or piece of ground within the city or within its extraterritorial zoning jurisdiction shall keep the lot or piece of ground and the adjoining streets and alleys free of any growth of six inches or more in height of weeds, grasses, or worthless vegetation.

It is hereby declared to be a nuisance to permit or maintain any growth of six inches or more in height of weeds, grasses, or worthless vegetation on any lot or piece of ground within the city or within its extraterritorial zoning jurisdiction or on the adjoining streets or alleys or to litter or cause litter to be deposited or remain thereon except in proper receptacles.

DAILY WATER RESTRICTIONS:

May 15—October 31, 2024

No watering or irrigation shall be allowed on Mondays of each week!

Odd Street Address Residents can water on Tuesday, Thursday, and Saturday’s of each week.

Even Street Address Residents can water on Wednesday, Friday, and Sunday’s of each week.
