### **NEW FOR 2024**

**Thanksgiving** 

With the December utility invoice you will receive a new garbage tag for the calendar year of 2024. Before, tags were sent in April and effective May 1 - April 30. Now that time frame will be January - December of each year. For those who use the Brush Only tags, those will also be sent in December. The Brush Only tags will not have a year printed on them and are a different color than the garbage tag. It will be active until a change is made on your account.

Now that fall is here, winter is just around the corner, so please keep in mind the requirements for a snow emergency.

PLEASE DO NOT PARK vehicles on the street. They could be towed at owner's expense. Please keep all walks cleared of snow and ice to prevent falls and injuries.

## WATER METER PIT/ANTENNA

The water meter pit and antenna are usually located at the front of the property near the street. When mowing or during snow removal, please be aware of the antenna on the top of the meter. The black round cap that has the word SENSUS on it is the antenna. If you run over it with a mower or in any way break it, you will be responsible for the cost to replace it and the current amount is \$240.26. After the new one is installed the charge will be added to the next monthly utility invoice. On the right is a picture that should be similar to what is on your property.
