

BENNET REFUSE SITE

1. The Refuse Site is located on the east side of Highway 43 south of Bennet.
2. The compactor is for **HOUSEHOLD GARBAGE ONLY!** (kitchen/bathroom type)
3. The **BRUSH** and **COMPOST** areas are for the use of permit holders and Bennet residents only. No commercial business including yard, lawn care or tree services should use this site. Brush Only in the brush area. Items **not allowed** in the brush/compost area: woodchips from trees, lumber of any kind, no wood that is glued, treated, painted, or contains nails, including green-treated and plywood. Large tree stumps are also prohibited. (Limbs limited to 4" diameter)
4. A **brush permit** can be issued to Bennet residents currently using an outside hauler like Uribe for their normal trash pick-up, at no cost.
5. **The Bennet refuse site does not accept contractor's debris.** Construction & demolition debris should be disposed of in a receptacle located on the property where the activity is taking place.
6. Appliances such as refrigerators, air conditioners and freezers are allowed to be placed in metal scrap containers.
7. **DO NOT** take tires, batteries, carpet, oil, mattresses, or furniture to the Refuse Site!
8. Hours of Operation: Tuesday and Thursday, Noon to 7:00 PM
Saturday, 9:00 AM to 5:00 PM.
9. A **one-time use** fee of \$35.00 can be paid at the refuse site per pick-up/trailer load for **HOUSEHOLD GARBAGE AND BRUSH**. (No construction debris)
