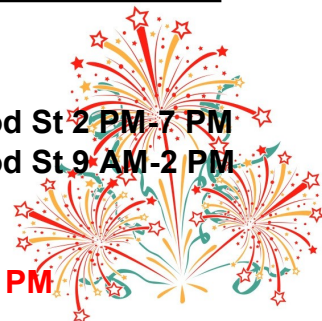

CELEBRATE BENNET PARADE ON JULY 4TH

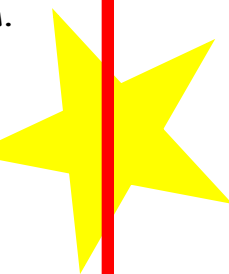
The parade route for the Celebrate Bennet Parade on the 4th of July will be on Monroe Street (Highway 43) from Cottonwood to Garden, starting at 10 am.

Registration for the parade participants will be at 9 am at the corner of Cottonwood and Monroe.

The highway will be temporarily shut down for through traffic and parking, 8 am to noon on July 4th from Birch Street south to Juniper Street.

The barricades will be removed once the parade is completed.

There will be no access to the highway during this time!
