Throughout the city there are several trees with branches hanging down over the streets that are lower than the allowed 14 feet. Take a look at the trees in your yard and see if you have overhanging branches above the street in front of your property. A portion of the municipal code is:

**MUNICIPAL CODE 93.18 OVERHANGING BRANCHES. (A) The owner or occupant of any lot, piece, or parcel of ground abutting or adjacent to any street or sidewalk over which there extends the branches of trees shall at all times keep the branches or limbs thereof trimmed to the height of at least eight feet above the surface of the walk and at least 14 feet above the surface of the street. The full Code 93 can be found on the city's website.**

The City of Bennet has purchased a used sewer jetting machine that can be used by staff to regularly jet (clean out) sewer lines throughout the city. The purpose is to try and alleviate as many sewer backups and blockages as possible and to provide regular maintenance of the city's sewer lines.

When jetting is happening in your area, you may experience sewer gas smell that will come up through any floor drains that are not full of water. This usually happens in the older homes that have a floor drain that is not properly vented. An alert will be sent out when the jetting is occurring and if you live in the area affected, you can be better prepared by pouring water in the floor drain.
